at setting a new try pot.

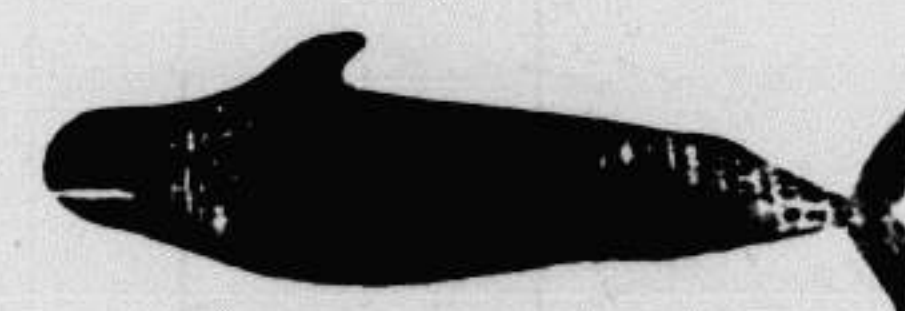
