180 Sat Saturday March 29th Commences with a strong breeze from S.E. running down along the S. side of Mowee, at 5 P.M. came to anchor at Lahaina, A.M. employed at scrubbing ship.
In Port, at the Sandwich islands, Port of Lahaina,

181 Sun Sunday March 30th Commences with pleasant weather P.M. took a raft of castor on shore for fresh water, at 8 A.M. sent Starboard water on shore on liberty.

182 Mon Monday March 31st Commences & ends with pleasant weather Starboard water a share on liberty, at 5 P.M. all came off, 1 M. watch employed at painting ship, one watch on liberty.

183 Tues Tuesday April 1st Commences with pleasant weather one watch on shore, the other employed at Ship's duty later part strong breezes from S.E. at 7 P.M. parted Starboard cable, with both anchors ahead, at 9 A.M. Moderated, all hands on board,

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184 Wed Wednesday April 2nd Commences with pleasant weather from S.W. crew employed at fishing for our anchor, all hands employed but have not got it, at 5 P.M. strong breezes again, from N.E. at 9 P.M. Moderated, at 10 A.M. commenced fishing for our anchor, & caught it, at noon 8 cable in. & anchor on the bow, or rather to the cathead, one watch on liberty at 4 P.M. took off our raft,

190 Tues Tuesday April 8th Commences with pleasant weather took on board 200 pumpkins, caught the two deserters & took them on board, put the Cooper's mate in irons for threatening to destroy the ship, put him in the run A.M. carried 50 barrels of meat on shore for storage, 25 bl. prime Pork & 25 bl. Mops Beef the Cooper's mate still in irons,
