374	Thursday Oct 9 th	Commenced with a moderate breeze from S.W. & rough sea from S.W. crew employed at washing Bore, 4 P.M., calm, course S. by E. A.M. Moderate.	Latt. by Obs. $32^{\circ} 74'$ Long. by chro. $154^{\circ} 48'$
375	Friday Oct 10 th	Commenced with moderate breezes from S.W. steering S. by E. crew employed at drying Bore, lost a new main topgallant sail, A.M. wind from S.W.	Latt. by Obs. $32^{\circ} 53'$ Long. by chro. $155^{\circ} 32'$
376	Saturday Oct 11 th	Commenced with moderate breezes & pleasant weather from S.W. heading S. by E. crew employed at drenching Bore, last part of A.M. strong squalls from S.W. & rain.	Latt. by Obs. $28^{\circ} 00'$ Long. by chro. $155^{\circ} 01'$
377	Sunday Oct 12 th	Commenced with strong breezes from S.W. steering S. by E. & some rain, A.M. Moderate.	Latt. by Obs. $25^{\circ} 47'$ Long. by chro. $155^{\circ} 02'$
378	Monday Oct 13 th	Commenced with strong breezes from S.W. steering S. by E. for part of A.M. variable winds last part from E. crew employed at drenching Bore.	Latt. by Obs. $23^{\circ} 54'$ Long. by chro. $155^{\circ} 10'$
379	Tuesday Oct 14 th	Commenced with moderate breezes from S.W. steering S. by E. crew employed at drenching Bore at 9 A.M. saw the island of Chowee, bearing S.W. distant 60 miles.	
380	Wednesday Oct 15 th	Commenced with moderate breezes from S.W. steering S.W. for the end of Chowee. P.M. bent the cables to the anchors, at 9 A.M. came to anchor, with the Starboard Bower, found 30 ships lying here.	
381	Thursday Oct 16 th	Commenced with pleasant weather, lying to anchor at Chowee. P.M. sent a raft of casks on shore for fresh water, A.M. Starboard watch on Liberty.	
382	Friday Oct 17 th	Commenced with pleasant weather, Starboard watch on Liberty, A.M. employed at delivering our Bore on board of Bark. Helen Augusta of New Bedford.	

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383	Saturday Oct 18 th	Commenced with pleasant weather one watch on Liberty, transhipped 142 Bundles of Bore weighing 14421 pounds, on Board of Bark. Helen Augusta of New Bedford Captain Cook, A.M. took a raft of water on Board.	
384	Sunday Oct 19 th	Commenced with pleasant weather one watch on Liberty, three 24 hours under the gun.	
385	Monday Oct 20 th	Commenced with pleasant weather one watch on Liberty, A.M. some rain.	
386	Tuesday Oct 21 st	Commenced with dusk. cloudy weather from S. some rain P.M. sold one barrel of oil for 20 cents, A.M. pleasant.	
387	Wednesday Oct 22 nd	Commenced with pleasant weather one watch on Liberty, sold one barrel of oil for 20 cents, A.M. pleasant.	
388	Thursday Oct 23 rd	Commenced pleasant, one watch on Liberty, A.M. all hands on board, employed at ship's duty.	
389	Friday Oct 24 th	Commenced with pleasant weather all hands employed at ship's duty, at 11 A.M. took anchor & got underweigh. sold one barrel of oil.	
390	Saturday Oct 25 th	Commenced with pleasant breezes from S.W. lying off & on the Harbor at 2 P.M. Captain came on board, steering W. by N. at 4 A.M. saw the island of Waikoo, at 10 A.M. sent one boat in at the port of Honolulu to purchase a spear for main yard.	
391	Sunday Oct 26 th	Commenced with pleasant weather & moderate breezes from S.W. lying off & on the Harbor of Honolulu at 5 P.M. Captain came on board, steering W. by N. A.M. heading S.W. & wind from E.	
392	Monday Oct 27 th	Commenced with pleasant breezes from S.W. heading S.W. & Waikoo in sight, A.M. pleasant. Hoveed away the cables & lashed the anchors on the Bore.	Latt. by Obs. $23^{\circ} 74'$ Long. by chro. $155^{\circ} 50'$
393	Tuesday Oct 28 th	Commenced with pleasant breezes from S.W. heading S.W. & Waikoo in sight, A.M. pleasant. Hoveed away the cables & lashed the anchors on the Bore.	
394	Wednesday Oct 29 th	Commenced with moderate breezes from S.W. heading S.W. employed at making a main yard, A.M. pleasant.	Latt. by Obs. $25^{\circ} 16'$ Long. by chro. $154^{\circ} 28'$
