Say from Sunday Oct 10<sup>th</sup> Commences with moderate breezes from S.E. Ship from  
Ship heading E, under all sail, three 24 hours  
the wind has been alternately strong & moderate,  
a heavy swell from S. Lat. by Obs. 57.57  
Long. by Chron. 147.16

Monday Oct 11<sup>th</sup> Commences with moderate breezes of a heavy swell  
from S.E. Ship heading E, A.M. light air from W.  
Ship steering S.E. Lat. by Obs. 58.01  
Long. by Chron. 145.59

Tuesday Oct 12<sup>th</sup> Commences with light air & pleasant weather  
W. with a heavy swell from S. Ship steering S.E.  
the last of P.M. calm, A.M. the same,  
Lat. by Obs. 58.12  
Long. by Chron. 145.44

Wednesday Oct 13<sup>th</sup> Commences calm, A.M. light air from S.W.  
Lat. by Obs. 57.57  
Long. by Chron. 144.53

Thursday Oct 14<sup>th</sup> Commences with moderate breezes from  
S.W. Ship steering S.E. the last of P.M.,  
P.M. wind from S.E. Ship heading E. A.M. the  
same. Lat. by Obs. 59.15  
Long. by Chron. 142.12

Friday Oct 15<sup>th</sup> Commences calm, nearly the fore part of A.M.  
took light air from S. Lat. by Obs. 59.12  
Long. by Chron. 141.33

Saturday Oct 16<sup>th</sup> Commences with moderate breezes S. Ship steering  
E.S.E. A.M. strong breezes from S.W.  
Lat. by Obs. 57.56

Sunday Oct 17<sup>th</sup> Commences with a strong breeze from S.W. Ship  
steering E. by S. at 4 P.M. took in the Starboard  
the last of P.M. rain, at midnight moderated  
Ship under double reef topsails, at one A.M.  
wind from S.W. Lat. by Obs. 52.57  
Long. by Chron. 135.53

Monday Oct 18<sup>th</sup> Commences with moderate breezes from S.W.  
Ship heading E. by S. the last of P.M. & fore part  
A.M. calm. Lat. by Obs. 53.08  
Long. by Chron. 132.24

Tuesday Oct 19<sup>th</sup> Commences with moderate breezes from S.W.  
Ship steering E. by S. A.M. strong breezes  
Lat. by Obs. 56.32  
Long. by Chron. 130.14

Wednesday Oct 20<sup>th</sup> Commences with strong breezes from S. Ship  
steering E. S. E. the last of P.M. calm  
Lat. by Obs. 55.13  
Long. by Chron. 127.35

Thursday Oct 21<sup>th</sup> Commences calm, continues calm the whole  
24 hours, some fog, with two heavy squalls one  
from S.W. & the other from S.E.

Friday Oct 22<sup>th</sup> Commences calm, the last of P.M. moderate  
breezes from S.W. A.M. moderate breezes from W.  
& S.W. some fog.

Saturday Oct 23<sup>th</sup> Commences with moderate breezes from  
S.W. Ship steering E. by S. light fog the last  
of P.M. strong breeze, the last of A.M. a strong  
gale from S.W. Lat. by Obs. 57.26  
Long. by Chron. 120.36

Sunday Oct 24<sup>th</sup> Commences with a strong gale from S.W. Ship  
steering E. under a whole fore & main top-  
sails, at 4 P.M. moderated a little set fore &  
main topgallant sails, A.M. the same.  
Lat. by Obs. 48.15  
Long. by Chron. 116.35

Monday Oct 25<sup>th</sup> Commences with strong breezes from S.W. Ship  
steering E. by S. A.M. strong breezes from S.W.  
Weather squally. Lat. by Obs. 53.52  
Long. by Chron. 112.33

Tuesday Oct 26<sup>th</sup> Commences with strong squally breezes from S.W.  
Ship steering E. by S. the last of P.M. the wind  
heavy swell from S.E. hauled round W. in heavy squally double  
reefed fore topsail, the first of A.M. the same  
with continual rain, the last of A.M. wind  
from S.W. Lat. by Obs. 49.57  
Long. by Chron. 108.39

Wednesday Oct 27<sup>th</sup> Commences with strong breezes from S.W. Ship  
steering E. by S. with main topgallant sail set,  
at 4 P.M. took a strong gale from S. under the  
Ship too under a close reef main topsail, at  
8 moderated some. Lat. by Obs. 50.53  
Long. by Chron. 105.25

Thursday Oct 28<sup>th</sup> Commences with a strong breeze from S.W.  
Ship trying too under a close reef main  
topsail, at 1 P.M. steered off E. & set  
single reef topsails & main topgallant  
sails. A.M. rain & fog. Lat. by Obs. 57.58  
Long. by Chron. 101.16
