

Tuesday August 26th. 1834 All these 24 hours fine weather with light winds from the S. E. & steering by the wind to the N. W.

Lat. 25° 56' - - - - - Long 18° 11'

Wednesday August 27th. Fine weather all these 24 hours, wind S. E. by S.

Lat. 26° 42' - - - - - Long 18° 11'

Thursday August 28th. These 24 hours commences with light from the southward and Calms middle and latter part light winds from S. E. by S. one watch variously employed about the rigging

Lat. 27° 10' - - - - - Long 18° 20'

Friday August 29th. Commences with light winds from S. steering S. by E. middle and latter part winds from N. N. W. to E. ends.

Lat. 28° 24' - - - - - Long 18° 20'

Saturday August 30th. Begins with light winds from N. N. W. steering S. middle part the same latter part calm. so ends these 24 hours.

Lat. 30° 00' - - - - - Long 16° 53'

Sunday August 31st. Commences with light winds from the N. W. by N. steering S. E. by S. middle & latter part strong breeze studying sails set fore and aft so ends these 24 hours.

Lat. 31° 48' - - - - - Long 16° 53'

Monday Sept. 1st. First and middle part a fine breeze from N. W. by N. steering S. E. by S. with studying sails set on both sides latter part light winds and calm foggy and rainy so ends.

Lat. 32° 27' - - - - - Long 12° 34'

Tuesday Sept. 2nd. First of these 24 hours commences with moderate winds from W. W. W. steering S. E. middle part calm latter part fresh breezes from the E. N. E.

Wednesday Sept. 3rd. Commences with strong winds from N. W. by N. steering S. E. by S. of hiding sails set fore and aft at 6 P.M. took in the studying sails and Bow-Boat and shortened more sail at 10 P.M. more moderate made all sail again so ends.

Lat. 34° 30' - - - - - Long 7° 45'

Thursday Sept. 4th. Fine weather all these 24 hours with a strong wind from the N. W. steering S. E. under all sail studying sails set on both sides

Lat. 35° 36' - - - - - Long 4° 37'

Friday Sept. 5th. First & middle part fresh gales from the N. W. steering S. E. latter part equally took in the studying sails fore top gallant sail and Mizzen. Top sail at meridian the wind shifted to the W. by N. shipped a sea into Laboard quarter Boat which injured her very much

Lat. 36° 40' - - - - - Long 1° 14' W.

Saturday Sept. 6th. 1834. First part strong winds from the N. W. steering S. E. middle part calm latter part a fine Breeze from the N. W. all sail set so ends these 24 hours.

Lat. 37° 00' - - - - - Long 00° 14' E.

Sunday Sept. 7th. Winds from N. W. to S. W. and equally took in and made sail a number of times latter part moderate so ends these 24 hours.

Lat. 37° 45' - - - - - Long - - - - -

Monday Sept. 8th. Winds from N. W. to South took in and made sail a number of times fine weather ends the Day all sail set steering S. E.

Lat. 37° 53' - - - - - Long 0° 07' E.

Tuesday Sept. 9th. Commences with fresh breezes from the N. W. steering S. E. at 10 P.M. began to shorten sail at 10 P.M. hauling under Double Reefed Top sails and fore sail with a strong gale. so ends.

Lat. 38° 47' - - - - - Long 9° 19'

Wednesday Sept. 10th. Begins with a strong gale from the N. W. steering to the S. E. under Double Reefed Top Sails and Bow-Sail at 9 P.M. let one reef out of the N. W. Top sail and set the Main top Gallant sail a strong gale ends these 24 hours.

Lat. 39° 10' - - - - - Long 13° 40'

Thursday Sept. 11th. Begins with a strong Gale from the westward steering S. E. at 10 P.M. run the waist Boat under and lost her at 9 P.M. let out the reefs and set the 3 Gallant sails so ends these 24 hours.

Lat. 39° 44' - - - - - Long 17° 24'

Friday Sept. 12th. First and middle part winds from the N. W. steering S. E. & C. latter part winds from S. N. E. so ends all sail set.

Lat. 39° 55' - - - - - Long 20° 26'

Saturday Sept. 13th. Commences with fresh breezes from N. E. steering S. E. by E. all sail set at 9 P.M. began to shorten sail at midnight were from N. W. blowing hard under Double reefed fore and Main Top Sails & fore sail latter part more moderate made some sail so ends these 24 hours.

Lat. 40° 06' - - - - - Long 25° 08'

Sunday Sept. 14th. Begins with winds from the W. N. W. steering S. E. by E. all sail set latter part light winds from S. W. by N. so ends

Lat. 39° 56' - - - - - Long 28° 12'

Monday Sept. 15th. Commences with light winds from N. steering S. E. by E. middle part strong Breeze at 4 P.M. began to shorten sail at noon hauling under Close Reefed M. S. Sail and fore sail winds from N. W.

Lat. 39° 57' - - - - - Long 31° 55'

Tuesday Sept. 16th. Begins with a heavy Gale from N. W. steering S. E. by E. latter part moderate set the 3 Top sail let out the reefs and set the 2 M. Top Gallant sail.
