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Wednesday July 15 All these 24 hours fine weather with light winds from the Eastward at 2 P.M. finished cutting at 6 Do. commenced boiling oil ends the Day steering on Different tacks by the wind at Meridian Pachenuva 20 miles Distance.

Thursday July 16 All these 24 hours light winds from the Eastward and fine weather steering on different tacks by the wind at 9 P.M. finished boiling oil at 6 Do. commenced breaking out the fore hole, at 8 Do. commenced storing Down oil so ends the Day Pachenuva 18 miles Distance.

Friday July 17th First part storing Down oil with light winds from the Eastward and fine weather, at 7 Do. saw a sperm whale going quick to the windward at 8 Do. lost sight of him, Middle and latter part squally, attended with light showers of rain steering on Different tacks by the wind, Pachenuva in sight.

Saturday July 18th Commences with strong winds from the Eastward steering on Different tacks by the wind, Middle part the same, latter part fine weather so ends these 24 hours all sail set, Round Island bearing S. by W. Lat 15.50 S.

Sunday July 19th. Commences with light winds from the Eastward and fine weather middle and latter part strong winds from N. by E. to S. E. attended with showers of rain steering on Different tacks by the wind, at midnight saw a whale, nothing more to be remarked. Lat 15.41 S Long

Monday July 20th. All these 24 hours strong winds and variables, steering on Different tacks by the wind, latter part employed in storing Down oil, Pachenuva in sight. Lat 15.47 S. Round Island bearing S. by W.

Tuesday July 21st. Commences with strong winds from the N. W. steering on Different tacks by the wind at 4 P.M. finished storing Down oil at sunset took in sail and headed to the westward at Daylight made sail and steered to the S. E. with winds the S. E. W. so ends these 24 hours Round Island bearing S. E. E. Lat 15.46 Long

Wednesday July 22nd. All these 24 hours fine weather, with light winds from the South westward steering on Different tacks by the wind, latter part employed in repairing the Main-Sail so ends these 24 hours Round Island bearing S. E. E. 15 miles Distance.

Thursday July 23rd. First part calm Middle and latter part light winds from the Eastward and fine weather, steering on Different tacks by the wind, employed in Sail Mending so ends these 24 hours, the middle of Pachenuva bearing S. E. 30 miles Distance.

Friday July 24th. All these 24 hours fine weather with winds from the S. E. steering on Different tacks by the wind, at Meridian Round Island bearing S. E. 20 miles Distance.

Saturday July 25th. This Day light winds from the Eastward and fine weather

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steering on Different tacks by the wind, at Meridian Pachenuva bearing S. E. by E. 35 miles Distance.

Sunday July 26th. Commences with light winds from the Eastward at 2 P.M. saw a whale at 3 Do. however, at sunset the Boats returned to the Ship without catch, middle and latter part strong winds from the S. E. steering on Different tacks by the wind, at meridian the middle of Pachenuva bearing S. by E. 30 miles Distance.

Monday July 27th. First part strong winds from the Eastward, at sunset shortened Sail, Middle and latter part thick weather, and thunder attended with rain, steering on Different tacks by the wind under short Sail. All Meridian Round Island bearing S. by W. 25 miles Distance.

Tuesday July 28th. First and Middle, light winds from the Eastward, and thick weather, Thunder attended with showers of rain, latter part fine weather steering on different tacks by the wind, all sail set, so ends Round Island bearing S. 12 miles Distance.

Wednesday July 29th. All these 24 hours strong winds from the Eastward steering on different tacks by the wind, variously employed about the riggin so ends these 24 hours, Round Island bearing S. 14 miles Distance.

Thursday July 30th. First and middle part strong gales from the S. E. at sunset doubled reefed the Top-Sails, took in the Jib and Fore-Sail at 10 P.M. took in the Fore & Mizzen Top-Sails and close reefed the Main, latter part more moderate, made some Sail, so ends these 24 hours steering on Different tacks by the wind, the middle of Pachenuva bearing S. E. 40 miles Distance at meridian,

Friday July 31st. This Day strong winds from the Eastward steering on different tacks by the wind under short Sail middle and latter part thick weather, attended with light showers of rain, so ends the day Pachenuva in sight. Lat 15.48 S

Saturday August 1st. All these 24 hours strong winds from the Eastward and thick weather attended with showers of rain steering on different tacks by the wind, so ends, the middle of Pachenuva bearing S. E. 30 miles Distance.

Sunday August 2nd. First and Middle part strong winds from the S. E. attended with heavy rain, at 2 P.M. took in all three Top-Sails and have to head to the Eastward, at 10 Am. more Ship to the southward and set the Main-Top-Sail close reefed with a strong gale from the E. so ends the Day. Lat 15.12

Monday August 3rd. First part more moderate at 2 P.M. set the fore and Mizzen Top-Sails, Double reefed, Jib and Spanker, the remainder of the Day steering on different tacks by the wind, strong winds and squally, land in sight.
