

Sunday June 5th. All these 24 hours winds from the Eastward and fine weather Steering on Different tacks by the wind, at 6 Am. saw a Barque to the Leeward Steering to the S.W. so ends variously employed about the rigging, at Meridian Cheak bearing S.E. 12 miles Distance.

Monday June 6th. All these 24 hours winds from the Eastward and fine weather Steering on Different tacks by the wind, at 6 Am. saw a Barque to the Leeward Steering to the S.W. so ends variously employed about the rigging, at Meridian Cheak bearing S.W. by S. Lat. 15° 59' S.

Tuesday June 7th. All these 24 hours strong winds from the Eastward Steering to the S.E. by the wind, at Sunset took in the fore, Mizzen Sail, and Mizzen Pop Sail, and Double reefed the Fore and Main Pop Sails, at 6 Am. Barrenwell Island bore S.E. 15 miles Distance, at 8 Do. unbutton the Mizzen Pop Sail, so ends repairing the Pop Sail

Wednesday June 8th. All this Day Strong winds from the Eastward at 6 Am. wore Ship, and set the Mizzen Pop Sail Double reefed, at 8 Am. unbutton the Fore Sail, so ends under Doubled reefs, employed in repairing the Fore Sail

Thursday June 9th. Commences with strong winds from the Eastward and Steering to the Southward by the wind, under Double reefed Pop Sails at 3 P.M. bent the Fore Sail, at Sunset hove to under Short Sail, heading on Different tacks through the night at Daylight set the Pop Sails Double reefed, fore and Fore Sail at 8 Am. made Barrenwell Island bearing S.E. Strong winds ends

Friday June 10th. Commences with strong winds from the Eastward, Steering to the Southward by the wind, at Sunset hove to under a close reefed Main Pop Sail heading to the S.W. at 4 Am. wore Ship and set the Fore Sail, so ends under a close reefed Main Pop Sail and Fore Sail with a Strong Gale from the Eastward.

Saturday June 11th. All these 24 hours Strong Gale from the Eastward Steering on Different tacks by the wind under a close reefed Main Pop Sail and Fore Sail, Packanura in sight, so ends at Meridian Cheak bearing S. by E. by Compass 18 mi. Dis.

Sunday June 12th. All these 24 hours Strong Gale from the Eastward with rain, heading on Different tacks under a close reefed Main Pop Sail and Fore Sail, Packanura in sight -

Monday June 13th. First and Middle part Strong Gale from the E. Steering on Different tacks by the wind under a close reefed Main Pop Sail and Fore Sail, at 7 Am. set the Fore Pop Sail Double reefed and let one reef out of the Main, at 10 Do. set the fore and Mizzen Pop Sail Double reefed, so ends variously employed, Packanura in sight.

Tuesday June 14th. Commences with Strong Gale from the E. Steering on Different tacks by the wind under Double reefs, middle part the same latter part more moderate, all Sail set, at 11 Am. Cheak bearing S.E. 3 miles Distance, lowered the Laboard and West Boats and pulled in to the reef about one mile Distance, boarded a canoe and brought a few Yams, at Meridian returned to the Ship, so ends lying aback waiting for the Canoes to come to the Ship

Wednesday June 15th. At 4 P.M. finished trading with the natives and Steered to the W.S.W. at Sunset shortened Sail at Daylight made all Sail and Steered to the Westward so ends Packanura in sight

Thursday June 16th. Commences with Strong Winds from the S.E. Steering to the Westward at half past Meridian made Round Island at 4 P.M. saw sperm whales, and lowered 4 Boats, at 5 Do. the west, starboard and bow boats, fastened to the whales, at 6 Do. the Starboard and West Boats took two whales to the Ship, at Midnight the Bow boat took her Whale to the Ship, at 6 Am. commenced cutting so ends Round in sight bearing S.E.

Friday June 17th. At 6 P.M. finished cutting, and commenced cutting up the heads and clearing the Decks, at midnight commenced boiling so ends the Day boiling the Whales, with Strong winds from the S.E. and a number of Islands in sight to the South Eastward.

Saturday June 18th. Commences with Strong Winds from the S.E. heading on Different tacks by the wind at 6 Am. set the Fore and Mizzen Pop Sails Double reefed, at 11 Do. finished boiling so ends a number of Islands in sight bearing from S. by E. to E.

Sunday June 19th. Commences with winds from the S.E. and fine weather Steering on Different tacks by the wind under short Sail, at 4 P.M. finished clearing and washing Decks, and mending holes, at Sunset took in Sail at Daylight made all Sail so ends a number of Islands in sight.
