came on board light winds and fine weather ends the Day all sail set.

Monday July 4th. Commences with winds from the S. E. Steering to
the S. E. at Sunset took in the Top-Gallant sails, jib, Courses, and Double
reefed the Top-Sails, at 10 P.M. Capt. Sampson went on board his
Ship, the remainder of the night lying with the head yards aback at
Daylight made Sail and Steered to the E. so ends in company with the
Hafsa, at Meridian the West part of Packanura bearing S. by E.
Okeah E. 1/2 S. - Lat. of the Ship 16° 12' S. - Long 150° 41' E. -

Tuesday July 5th. Commences with winds from the S. E. Steering
to the E. at Sunset Shortened Sail, Okeah bearing E. 6 miles
Distance, heading on Diffrent tack through the night, at Daylight
made some Sail and heading in for the land, at 9 A.M. Okeah bore
E. 4 miles Distance, 4 Canoes came along side with a few yams, Coconuts
mats &c. at 11 Do. brought them out and the Canoes departed at half
past 11 Do. Capt. Parker went on board the Hafsa, so ends the Day

Wednesday July 6th. This Day light winds from the Eastward. Steering
on Diffrent tack by the wind carrying easy Sail through the night, at 12 A.M.
saw a Ship inside the reef of Packanura Steering to the Eastward,
at 9 Do. theatives came of Okeah in their Canoes to trade, so ends
Trading with theatives in Company with the Hafsa.

At Meridian Okeah bearing E. 4 mi. Dis.
Thursday July 7th. Commences with Winds from the S. E. at 2 P.M.
finished Trading with theatives, and Steered to the S. E. at
Sunset Double reefed the Top-Sails, at Daylight let the reefs out
so ends Steering to the Northward by the wind in company with
Hafsa, Packanura, and Farewell Island in sight

Lat. 15° 20' S. - Long 150° 20' E.
Friday July 8th. This Day winds from the Eastward Steering to
the S. E. by the wind carrying easy Sail through the night so ends
these 24 hours in company with the Hafsa

Lat. 14° 55' S. - Long 149° 46' E.
Saturday July 9th. This Day winds from the Eastward Steering on Diff-
ferent Courses to the Northward in company with the Hafsa

Lat. 13° 48' S. - Long 149° 39' E.
Sunday July 10th. All these 24 hours Brisk winds from the Eastward
Steering to the S. E. by E. in company with the Hafsa

Monday July 11th. All these 24 hours winds from the Eastward Stee-
ring to the S. E. in company with the Hafsa, so ends variously employed
Lat. 11° 07' S. - Long 149° 41' W.

Tuesday July 12th. Commences with light winds from the Eastward
Steering to the S. E. at Sunset Shortened Sail, at Daylight made all Sail and
Steered to the W. at 10 A.M. made Matterson Island bearing W. by S. saw bottom
sounded in 12 fathoms water, Steered to the S.W. at Meridian the Island bore W. 1/2 S.
Lat. 12° 51' S. - Long 149° 43' E. -

Wednesday July 13th. Commences with winds from the S. E. Steering to the
S. W. at Sunset Shortened Sail, at Daylight made all Sail and Steered to the
S. W. at Meridian the Mattersons Island bore E. by S. 4 miles Distance
Lat. of the Island bearing 10° 47' S. Long 149° 34' E. -

Thursday July 14th. All these 24 hours winds from the
S. E. at 1 P.M. lowered the Staboard and Waist boats and went on shore
on Mattersons Island in company with Capt. Sampson, at 4 Do. returned
to the Ship, with two Boat loads of wood, at Sunset shortened Sail, at
Daylight made all sail, at 10 A.M. took in the Top-Gallant sails, so ends in com-
pany with the Hafsa, at Meridian the Island bearing S. E. by S. -
Lat. by obs. 10° 40' S. -

Friday July 15th. Commences with strong winds from the S. E. E.
Steering to the Southward by the wind under Double reefs, at Sunset
took in the jib, and Main Sail, at Daylight set the jib and Main Sail
and let one reef out of the Top-Sails, so ends in company with the Hafsa.
Lat. 11° 54' S. - Long 148° 43' E. -

Saturday July 16th. All these 24 hours strong winds from the S. E.
Steering to the Southward by the wind under Double reefs Pop Sail
in Company with the Hafsa so ends -
Lat. 13° 12' S. - Long 147° 49' East.

Sunday July 17th. Commences with strong winds from the S. E.
Steering to the Southward by the wind under Double reefs,
at sunset took in the Fore, and Mizzen Pop-Sails, and jib, at Daylight
set the Fore and Mizzen Pop-Sails, so ends in company with the Hafsa
Lat. 14° 00' S. - Long 146° 55' E. -

Monday July 18th. Commences with strong winds from the S. E. Steer-
ing to the S. W. by the wind under Double reefs, at Sunset took in the Fore
and Mizzen Pop-sails, at 10 A.M. set the Fore and Mizzen Pop-sails, Close reefed
so ends in company with the Hafsa -
Lat. 14° 52' S. - Long 146° 11' E. -

Tuesday July 19th. First and middle part strong winds from the
S. E. Steering on Diffrent tack by the wind under Close reefs, latter
part more moderate at 10 A.M. let all the reefs out so ends Steering
