Wednesday July 29th. Commences with strong winds from the Eastward, steering to the Southward by the wind, at Sunset shortened Sail, Middle and Latter part moderate, at 6 AM made all Sail so ends variously employed, in company with the *Rafae*.

Thursday July 30th. Commences with winds from the E. steering to the Southward by the wind all Sail set in company with the *Rafae* at 5 PM. Capt. Sampson came onboard at Sunset Double reefed the Fore-Sails at 7 Do. Capt. Sampson went onboard his Ship at Daylight made all Sail so ends steering to the Southward by the wind in company with the *Rafae* variously employed about the rigging.

Friday July 31st. First part steering to the S.E. with winds from the E. S. Middle part heading to the Northward under short Sail, at Daylight made all Sail more Ship and steered to the Southward by the wind so ends in company with the *Rafae*.

Saturday July 31st. All these 24 hours winds from the N.W. E. steering to the Eastward by the wind in company with the *Rafae* at 6 AM made the land, at Meridian Myrrorby bore S.E. by E. Ambrose and a number of other Islands in sight so ends the day.

Sunday July 31st. All these 24 hours winds from the N.W. E. steering on different tacks by the wind in company with the *Rafae*, so ends Ambrose in sight.

Monday July 31st. Commences with winds from the N.W. E. steering to the westward by the wind, at Sunset Double reefed the Fore-Sails, took in the Jib and Main-Sail, middle and latter part squally, attended with rain, steering on different tacks by the wind under short Sail so ends in company with the *Rafae*.

Tuesday July 31st. Windy day winds from the Southward steering on different courses to the Northward in company with the *Rafae* carrying easy Sail through the night, at Meridian Ambrose and a number of other Islands in sight so ends.

Wednesday July 31st. Commences with winds from the N.W. steering to the N.W. at Sunset Double reefed the Fore-Sails, heading

on different tacks through the night by the wind, at Daylight made all Sail and steered to the Northward, so ends in company with the *Rafae* at Meridian a number of Islands in sight bearing from N.W. to S.E.

Thursday July 31st. Commences with winds from the E. steering on different tacks course to the Northward at 4 PM. Saw sperm Whales and lowered 4 Boats in company with the *Rafae* at Sunset returned to the Ship without success saw the *Rafae* take a Whale Coarct Island bearing S.E. 6.12 miles Dis. heading on different tacks through the night under short Sail, at Daylight made all Sail, saw the *Rafae* cutting, steered to the Eastward by the wind, at 10 AM tacked Ship so ends the *Rafae* in sight at Meridian Coarct Island bearing S. by W. 2 W. 16 miles Dis. Lat. by obs.
16° 55' S.

Friday July 31st. Commences with light winds from the S.E. steering on different courses to the Southward two Canoes came of from Coarct Island to land, lowered a boat and boarded them and got a few Banannas, at 5 PM Capt. Parker went onboard the *Rafae* at 8 Do. returned onboard, Middle and latter part steering on different tacks by the wind with winds from the E. so ends Coarct Island bearing S.E. 10 mi Dis.

Saturday July 31st. First and middle part winds from the Eastward steering on different tacks by the wind at 10 AM. saw sperm Whales Coarct Island bearing S. by E. 4 mi Dis. at 11 Do. lowered 4 Boats, so ends so ends in pursuit of the Whales.

Sunday July 31st. at 1 PM. the Waist Boat fastened, at 2 Do. the Whale to the Ship, for he sank very heavy, at half past 4 Do. the Bow Boat fastened, at 5 Do. Waist Boat put of from the Ship and fastened, at 6 Do. the Labourer fastened at Sunset took the fourth Whale to the Ship, at 8 AM. commenced cutting, so ends cutting the whales, with strong winds from the Eastward so ends in sight.

Monday August 1st. at 5 PM. finished cutting at 7 Do. commenced boiling at 4 PM. passed a Ship boiling, so ends under a close reefed Main Top-Sail and Fore-Sail boiling the whale.

Tuesday August 1st. First and middle part strong winds from the Eastward and thick weather, latter part thunder attended with rain, at 2 PM. cooled down, at 8 AM. got up and steaming and got the works on again, so ends under a close reefed Main Top-Sail and Fore-Sail in company with the *Rafae*.

Wednesday August 1st. First part light variable winds and rain at 5 PM. finished boiling at half past 5 Do. Capt. Sampson came onboard, at 6 Do. Capt. Sampson left the
