

Tuesday Sept. 20th. Commenced with winds from the Eastward and equally steering to the Southward by the wind, Middle and latter part fine weather steering to the Southward all sail set so ends these 24 hours Cheak bearing S. 16 mi. Dis. -
Lat. 14° 00' N. -

Wednesday Sept. 21st. This Day winds from the Eastward steering on different tacks by the wind, at 3 P.M. spoke Ship Rapa 33 months out 2300 bls. Capt. Thompson came on board, at 9 Do. Capt. Thompson went on board his Ship, latter part employed in stowing down oil, so ends employed in company with the Rapa, land in sight.

Thursday Sept. 22nd. This Day winds from the E. steering on different courses, at 5 P.M. Capt. Thompson went on board the Rapa, at 9 Do. returned, at 10 Do. saw Swatches to my down nothing more to be remarked, so ends Cheak bearing S. 10 mi. Dis.

Friday, Sept. 23rd. Commenced with winds from the Eastward and fine weather, at 1 P.M. a number of Canoes came off from Cheak with a few Yams, Shells, &c. for trade, at 4 Do. finished trading with the Indians, the remainder of the Day steering on different tacks by the wind carrying short sail through the night, so ends Cheak bearing S. E. 15 mi. Dis.

Saturday Sept. 24th. All these 24 hours light winds from the Eastward steering on different tacks by the wind, so ends Cheak bearing S. 25 mi. Dis.

Sunday Sept. 25th. Commenced with winds from the E. and thick weather attended with heavy Showers of rain, at 5 P.M. Double reefed the Pop. Hails, took in the Jib and Main Sail, Middle part the same latter part light winds from the S. W. and fine weather steering to the S. by E. all sail set, so ends Cheak bearing S. 18 mi. Dis. -

Monday Sept. 26th. Commenced with light winds from the Eastward steering on different tacks by the wind, Middle part Calm, latter part thick weather, and Thunder attended with heavy showers of rain, so ends steering on different tacks under Double reefs, with winds from the S. W. E.

Tuesday Sept. 27th. Commenced with light winds from the Eastward sailing steering to the S. W. by the wind, at 2 P.M. the rain cleared off, at 5 Do. saw Green Whales, 4 miles Distance, at half past 5 Do. lowered 4 Boats, at Sunset gave up the chase and returned to the Ship

without success, Middle part attended with showers of rain, latter part light winds, and fine weather steering on different tacks, so ends these 24 hours Cheak bearing S. 65 miles Distance, - Lat. 15° 42' N. -

Wednesday Sept. 28th. All these 24 hours light winds from the Eastward and fine weather steering on different tacks by the wind, variously employed about the rigging, at Meridian Cheak bearing S. E. 12 mi. Dis. so ends

Thursday Sept. 29th. First and Middle part light variable winds and Calm, steering on different courses, latter part winds from the E steering on to the S. W. by the wind at Meridian Pachamara and Farewell Sound in sight, so ends these 24 hours. -

Lat. 15° 49' N. -

Friday Sept. 30th. First part steering to the S. E. all sail set, Middle and latter part steering on different tacks, under Double reefs with strong winds from the S. E. so ends at Meridian Farewell S. bearing S. E. by S.

Lat. 15° 16' N. -

Long. 179° 57' E. -

Saturday Oct. 1st. Commenced with strong winds from the S. W. E. steering to the Southward by the wind, at Sunset shortened sail, at 10 Do. set the Fore and Mizzen Pop. Hails Double reefs, latter part steering on different courses to the Westward, strong winds into the Day no land in sight

Lat. 15° 29' N. -

Sunday Oct. 2nd. Commenced with strong winds from the S. W. E. steering to the Southward by the wind, Middle part heading to the Southward under short sail latter part steering to the southward under Double reefs, so ends Cheak bearing S. 32 mi. Dis.

Lat. 15° 45' N. -

Long. 179° 09' E. -

Monday Oct. 3rd. All these 24 hours strong winds from the Eastward steering on different tacks by the wind, latter part thick weather so ends

Lat. 15° 30' N. -

Tuesday Oct. 4th. Commenced with strong winds from the Eastward steering to the Southward by the wind, Middle part Thunder attended with rain, heading on different tacks under a close reefed Main Pop. Hail latter part light winds and variables attended with showers of rain

Lat. 15° 01' N. -

Wednesday Oct. 5th. This Day light variables winds and equally attended with Showers of rain, steering on different courses at 10 Do. under the Fore-sail and bent another, so ends variously employed.

Lat. 15° 52' N. -

Long. 179° 13' E. -

Thursday Oct. 6th. All these 24 hours light variable winds and Calm, attended with Showers of rain. Lat. 15° 35' N. - Long. 179° 20' E.
