

Sunday August 20th. All these 24 hours light winds from the East and fine weather. at 5 P.M. saw Sperm whales and lowered our our Boats, but being large whales and having only one rising before Dark, returned onboard at 6 Do. and Steered to the W. by S. so ends nothing more to be remarked

Monday August 21st. All these 24 hours light winds from the E. and fine weather Steering to the E. by S. all sail set, latter part employed in setting up rigging

Tuesday August 22nd. All these 24 hours light winds from E. S. E. to E. N. E. Steering to the W. by S.

Wednesday August 23rd. First part light winds and variables attended with showers of rain, latter part British winds from the S. E. Steering to the W. by S. all sail set variously employed

Thursday August 24th. Commences with light winds from the S. E. and overcast, at 4 P.M. took a strong Gale from the S. attended with rain took in all sail except a Double reefed Main S. Sail, and Fore Sail, and sent down the Royal Yards, at 6 Do. set the Fore Top sail Double reefed, at 6 Do. let one reef out of the Topsails and set the Mizzen Top sail Single reefed, at 8 Do. set the Jib Mainsail, and Main Topgallant sail so ends with Strong winds from the S. Steering to the W. by S.

Friday August 25th. All these 24 hours Strong Gales from the S. E. and overcast Steering to the W. by S. at 2 P.M. let out the reefs and set the Fore & Mizzen Topgallant sails, and Spanker, so ends

Saturday August 26th. All these 24 hours Strong Gales from the S. E. and overcast Steering to the W. by S. all sail set latter part Studingsails and Main royal out so ends variously employed

Sunday August 27th. All these 24 hours strong winds from the S. E. Steering to the W. 1/2 S. all sail set.

Monday August 28th. All these 24 hours strong winds from the S. E. and cloudy the most of the time, Steering to the W. 1/2 S.

Thursday August 31st. Commences with Strong Gales from the S. E. and Cloudy at 6 P.M. took in the Fore and Mizzen Royals, at 8 Do. took in the Main Royal, Main S. G. and Fore Topmast Studingunsails, Middle part equally attended with light showers of rain, at 3 Am. took in the Jib, and spanker, at 9 Do. the Main Sail split and one half blew away took in the Fore & Mizzen S. Gallantsails and unbent the Main Sail, at 10 Do. sent down the Royal yards, at 11 Do. took in the M. Topgallant sail so ends with Strong Gales from the S. E. Steering to the W. by S.

Thursday Sept. 1st. Commences with Strong Gales from the S. E. and Cloudy, at 1 P.M. bent another Main Sail, and unbent the Fore Sail & S. S. Sail and bent others, at 10 Do. set the Topgallantsails at 6 Am. set the S. S. Studingsail latter part Strong winds and clear weather employed in sail mending so ends these 24 hours
