

C. W. Morgan from West Islands to Cape Verde
Friday August 8th 1845

Begins with fresh trades from E.
all sail out steering S by E the
middle & latter part fine weather
and so on. Lat 23=35 N Long 25=35 W

Saturday August 9th 1845
Begins with fine trades and steering
S with all sail set the latter part the
sunny and saw nothing so on. Lat 23=35 N Long 25=33 W

Sunday August 10th 1845
Begins with fine trades from S. E. &
steering S by E the middle & latter
part fine weather and saw nothing
of note. Lat 18=43 N Long 25=44 W

Monday August 11th 1845
Begins with fine breezes from S. E.
steering S at 2 PM saw our sail
steering S W at 7 we hauled up the
courses for the night supposing the island
of St. Antonio 50 miles distant having S by E
at 12 light to for day. Light at 3 PM
light of S at 10 saw the Island of St. Antonio
having S. by W 12 miles and we
kept of to the Westward of it so on. Lat 18=00 N Long 25= W

Tuesday August 12th 1845

Begins with light breezes from N. N. E.
steering S W along the land the middle
light airs from E. Calm and under the lee
of the land at 2 PM took a strong breeze
from E and steering S by E the latter part
the same. Lat 15=13 N Long 25=00 W

C. W. Morgan Continued
Wednesday August 13th 1845

Begins with fresh breezes from E. S. E. and
steering S by E at 2 PM saw the
Island of Brava 8 miles distant at 4 we
lowered a boat and went on shore to
buy a Madinger and separate at 5 same
of and in company with the Magnolia
of St. Redford at 10 PM both ships put
away steering S by W the latter part
fine weather and the other Captain on
board so on. Lat 13=57 N Long 25=10 W

Thursday August 14th 1845
Begins with light breezes from S. E.
steering S by W & S W the middle
fine and at 3 PM both ships heading S.
S. E. in company with the Magnolia
the latter part light airs so on. Lat 13=08 N Long 25=04 W

Friday August 15th 1845
Begins with light airs from the
S W and steering S in company
with the Magnolia the middle and
latter part rain and light airs from
various ways. Lat 13=00 N Long 25=00 W

Saturday August 16th 1845
Begins with light airs from S. E. and
steering S. N. E. in company with the
Magnolia the middle and latter part
light airs and calm and steering S.
so on. Lat 12=02 N Long 25=55 W

Sunday August 17th 1845
Begins with light airs from N. E. and
steering S at 1 PM both the Fore & Mast
Riddling sail & a plenty of rain to day the
middle & latter part light airs from the S W
and S. E. and steering S by E Lat 11=10 N Long 25=20 W
