

Ship C. W. Morgan Outward Bound
Monday August 18th 1845

Begins with light breezes from S.W. steering
S at 2 P.M. the wind held forward and
took in Studding Sail and bristled sharp
by the wind the latter part a fine breeze
and steering S. Lat 9-35 N Long 23-50 W

Tuesday August 19th 1845

Begins with moderate breezes from W and
steering S the middle and latter part
wind from S.W. and light sail in
heading S by S. Lat 9-25 N Long 23-40 W

Wednesday August 20th 1845

Begins with strong winds from S.W.
a head sea and light sails in heading
S by S the middle and latter part
the same Lat 8-40 N Long 20-50 W

Thursday August 21st 1845

Begins with fresh breezes from S.W. heading
S by S the middle and latter part
strong winds and imployed rattling down
the lower rigging so until three 24 hour
Lat 8-39 N Long 19-20 W

Friday August 22nd 1845

Begins with fresh winds from S.W. and
heading S by S the middle and latter
part the same Lat 8-35 N Long 17-50 W

Saturday August 23rd 1845

Begins with fresh winds from S.W. and
heading S by S at 4 P.M. took ship to
the Westward middle and latter part the
same and saw 2 birds so until three
24 hour - Lat 8-07 N Long

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Sunday August 24th 1845

Begins with fresh wind from S.W. and
heading W by W and some showers of
rain the middle and latter part heading
to the S.E. and saw 2 birds so until
three 24 hours; Lat 8-28 N Long 17-07 W

Monday August 25th 1845

Begins with fresh winds from S.W.
and squalls of rain & sail in sight
bound South and we are heading S.E. by
S the middle the same at 8 P.M. took
ship to the Westward and 7 sail in sight
so until three 24 hours; Lat 8-30 N Long 15-40 W

Tuesday August 26th 1845

Begins with fresh breezes from S.W. and
heading W the middle part heading
S.E. latter part heading W by S
so until three 24 hours. Weather
7 sail; Lat 8-43 N Long 15-50 W

Wednesday August 27th 1845

Begins with strong winds from S.W.
and heading W by W the weather thick
the middle and latter part fresh winds
heading S.W. by W so until three 24
hour - Lat 8-32 N Long 16-57 W

Thursday August 28th 1845

Begins with fresh winds from S.W. by S.
and heading S.W. by W the middle and
latter part the wind S.E. and steering
S.W. by W with fore & main studding
sail set so until hands imployed &
rattling down the rigging -
Lat 12-58 N Long 19-51 W
