

Ship E W Morgan Outward Bound 1845

Friday Sept 19th 1845

Begins with light breezes from S W and during S. S. E. the middle and latter strong winds and heavy squalls off from W. during S. S. E. so ends this 24 hours

Lat 31° 53' Long 17° 10'

Saturday Sept 20th 1845

Begins with fresh winds from W and during S. S. E. and one sail in sight as then the middle and latter part fine weather and during S. S. E. so ends this 24 hours

Lat 36° 45' Long 13° 45'

Sunday Sept 21st 1845

Begins with light breezes from the S. heading S. S. E. at 4 P.M. were ship to the S W the wind to the S. E. the middle and latter part fine winds from the North at 5 P.M. saw the land bearing E by S dist 30 miles at Murrelson then in to the land and held a back

Monday Sept 22nd 1845

Begins with light breezes from the N and at 12 past Murrelson lowered a boat and the Capt went on shore at 1 P.M. of and lying off and on for the night the middle and latter part strong winds and rainy weather and lying to the wind at 8 P.M. so ends this 24 hours

Lat Long

Tuesday Sept 23rd 1845

Begins with strong gale from N and heading W. S. W. under short sail it raining quite hard the middle part the wind S. S. W. and lying off and on at 8 P.M. the boats went in after sunset so ends

Lat Long

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Wednesday Sept 24th 1845

Begins with fine weather and lying off and on at 3 P.M. got through bad line and part away to N E the wind S. S. E. the middle and latter part rainy and during S. S. E. so ends this 24 hours

Lat 35° 40' Long 10° 02'

Thursday Sept 25th 1845

Begins with light breezes from S W the middle part wind from the North and rainy latter clear and all sail out and with a light breeze

Lat 35° 39' Long 9° 02'

Friday Sept 26th 1845

Begins with light air from the North and rainy during S. S. E. with all sail out the middle a fine breeze from N. S. E. latter a strong breeze and clear weather and during S. S. E. so ends

Lat 38° 20' Long 5° 58'

Saturday Sept 27th 1845

Begins with strong winds from N. S. E. and under short sail during S. S. E. the middle rainy and the wind held to the Westward latter fine weather and all sail out so ends this 24 hours

Lat 38° 22' Long 3° 18'

Sunday Sept 28th 1845

Begins with fine breezes from S. and clear weather during S. S. E. at 4 P.M. saw 3 Right Whales the middle and latter fine weather and light breezes from the North during S. S. E.



Lat 38° 44' Long 10° 28' East

Monday Sept 29th 1845

Begins with light breezes from the North and all sail set the middle fresh breeze latter part blowing strong and light sails in so ends this 24 hours

Lat 38° 25' Long 3° 25' E
