

Ship E. W. Morgan Bound Across the Indian Ocean
Friday Oct 10th 1845

Begins with fine breeze from S.W. and
stern E. S. E. at 4 P.M. we set
the main top-sail and bent another the
mizzen and latter part the wind fresh
E and set ship to the S. so made then
24 hours and opened the Mizzen and bent
it again Lat 36° 40' S Long 29° 20' E

Saturday Oct 11th 1845

Begins with light breeze from E and
headline S. E. with all sail out to
the middle and latter part the wind
variable and shifting to the S. E. so
made then 24 hours, Lat 37° 28' Long 32° 11'

Sunday Oct 12th 1845

Begins with light breeze from S.W.
stern E. S. E. with all sail out at 5
P.M. put out the Larboard beam and
to starboard and saw a White Whale
the middle and latter part light
air and variable Lat 37° 07' Long 33° 10' E

Monday Oct 13th 1845

Begins with light breeze from the
S.W. and rain at 8 P.M. came a gale
from S.W. and doubled up the top
sail & stern S. E. by E at 9 it blowing
very heavy and close up to the latter part
wind held to the S.W. and moderated same
so well Lat 36° 38' S Long 36° 18' E.

Tuesday Oct 14th 1845

Begins with strong gale from S.W.
and stern E. by S at 1 P.M. made
some sail it abating some the middle and
latter a fine breeze and main top-gallant sail out
so ended then 24 hours. Lat 36° 00' S Long 39° 08' E.

Ship E. W. Morgan Crossing Indian Ocean
Wednesday Oct 15th 1845

Begins with fine breeze from S.W. and
pleasant weather steering S. E. by E. the middle
and latter the same to latter part a fresh
breeze light sail so ended then 24
hours Lat 36° 06' S Long 43° 30' East

Thursday Oct 16th 1845

Begins with fresh breeze from S.W. and
stern S. E. by E with all sail out at
7 P.M. took in S. & Mizzen top-gallant sail
the middle and latter part strong wind
from S. S. W. and set down so ended then
24 hours. Lat 35° 56' S Long 47° 40' E

Friday Oct 17th 1845

Begins with light breeze from the S.
and headline S. E. at 10 P.M. the
wind held to the North and a fine
breeze latter part much the same so
ended then 24 hours. Lat 36° 24' Long 50° 40' E

Saturday Oct 18th 1845

Begins with light breeze from the North
and all sail out steering S. E. by E
the middle and latter a fine breeze from
the North. Lat 36° 08' S Long 52° 46' E

Sunday Oct 19th 1845

Begins with fine wind from the North
stern S. E. by E and all sail out to
the middle and latter part the same and saw
nothing of Note. Lat 36° 25' S Long 55° 20' E.

Monday Oct 20th 1845

Begins with light breeze from the North steering
S. E. by E at 1 P.M. saw 2 Whales the middle
part strong latter blowing strong and set
top-sail so ended Lat 36° 30' S Long 58° 40' E.
