

Ship E. W. Morgan & Co. crossing Indian Ocean
Tuesday Oct 21st 1845

Begins with fresh breezes from the North
and steering E by E under double reef
top sail, the middle part fine the Wind W.
Latter light air from N. E. and steering
E by E. Lat 37° 25' S. Long 60° 50' E.

Wednesday Oct 22nd 1845

Begins with fine breezes from S E and
steering E by E with all sail out at 8
P.M. it blowing fresh took in top gallant
sail and reef the main top sail the
middle and latter part Wind W. S. W. and
steering E. S. E. Lat 37° 15' S. Long 61° 45' E.

Thursday Oct 23rd 1845

Begins with fresh winds from W. S. W.
and steering E. S. E. with fore top mast St.
sail out to the middle and latter part
light winds and a heavy swell on and
steering E. S. E. Lat 37° 18' S. Long 62° 15' E.

Friday Oct 24th 1845

Begins with light breezes from N. W. and
steering E. S. E. at 2 P.M. unhook the main
top gallant sail and bent another the
middle and latter part light breezes and saw
nothing of note Lat 37° 22' S. Long 60° 50' E.

Saturday Oct 25th 1845

Begins with light air from the N. W. and
steering E. S. E. the middle and latter part
cloudy and Wind N. E. and ends there 24
hours. Lat 37° 12' S. Long 72° 53' E.

Sunday Oct 26th 1845

Begins with light breezes from the North steering
W. E. the middle and latter part more fine and
steering S. E. Lat 38° 34' S. Long 61° 46' E.

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Monday Oct 27th 1845

Begins with fresh breezes from N. W. and steering
S. E. at 5 P.M. made the Island of St. Paul
bearing S. E. dist 15 miles and left to and
took in sail, and saw a ship to leeward the
weather thick the middle thick weather at
8 P.M. lowered the boat and went a fishing
to end Lat 38° 53' S. Long 77° 52' E.

Tuesday Oct 28th 1845

Begins with fresh breezes from N. W. and
thick weather at 1 P.M. the boat came
of and we put away steering E. at
4 P.M. at 5 P.M. the Wind held to S. S. E.
the middle and latter wind from E. S. E.
and sailing heading S. E. Lat 38° 30' S. Long 79° 30' E.

Wednesday Oct 29th 1845

Begins with light air from S. W. and
steering E. by S. the middle and latter part
a fine breeze from S. W. and steering E. by S.
to end Lat 38° 10' S. Long 80° 30' E.

Thursday Oct 30th 1845

Begins with fine breezes from S. W. and
steering E. by S. with all sail. Let the
middle and latter loosely and steering a
strong breeze & reef the top sails to end
there 24 hours Lat 37° 13' S. Long 87° 00' E.

Friday Oct 31st 1845

Begins with strong winds from S. W. and
steering E. by S. the middle fine at 8 P.M.
unhook the main top sail to mend a plank
bore in the Night at 9 P.M. bent it again
the 24 hours ended with fine weather
Wind S. W. Lat 38° 38' S.
Long 90° 00' E.
