Saturday Nov 22nd 1845

Begins with light breeze from W and steering
S. E. the middle part the same latter part a
fine breeze from N and saw a White Whale
thru 24 hours ends thus

Lat 30.55 Long 126.30 E

Sunday Nov 23rd 1845

Begins with fresh breeze from the North and
steering S. E. wind at 8 the wind held to the
S. W. at 11 reef top sails the middle and latter
part strong winds and cloudy weather &
under double reef - Lat 40.45 Long 128.00 E

Monday Nov 24th 1845

Begins with strong gales from W. S. W. and
steering S. E. by E under double reef and
covered the middle & latter part a strong breeze
from S. and S. W. Lat 45.18 Long 131.10 E

Tuesday Nov 25th 1845

Begins with strong breeze from the S and
steering S. E. by E the weather squally the latter
part more moderate and main top gallant sail cut
a heading E by S and implead mending main
top gallant Lat 48.10 Long 133.55 E

Wednesday Nov 26th 1845

Begins with light breeze from S. E. and
heading E & a plenty of Fin backs in sight
the latter part wind from E and heading S. E.
and saw White whale thru 24 hours
Lat 48.25 Long 136.00 E

Thursday Nov 27th 1845

Begins with fine breeze from E. S. E. and heading
N. E. and a plenty of W. whale thru the middle and
latter part fresh breeze from N. E. and heading E. S. E.
ends thus 24 hours. Lat 44.27 Long 139.15 E

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Friday Nov 28th 1845

Begins with strong winds from N. E. & heading
E. S. E. at 3 P. M. reef the top sail it steering
S. E. the latter part light breeze from the
North and foggy steering E. by S. ends thus
24 hours. Lat 45.25 Long 139.30 E

Saturday Nov 29th 1845

Begins with light breeze from the North and
steering E. by N the weather thick at 8 took
in the West boat to Point the middle moderate
latter light breeze from W. S. W. and fine weather
ends. Lat 45.05 Long 141.00 E

Sunday Nov 30th 1845

Begins with light breeze from W. S. W. steering
E. by N with all sail set the middle and latter
part fine weather wind S. W. ends thus 24
hours. Lat 44.59 Long 144.00 E

Monday Dec 1st 1845

Begins with light breeze from S. W. steering
E. with all sail set middle light air latter a strong
breeze from S. N. E. heading E. and reef top sails
ends with cloudy weather. Lat 45.20 Long 148.05 E

Tuesday Dec 2nd 1845

Begins with strong winds from N. N. E. and heading
E. the middle rain latter the same latter wind S. W.
and fine weather steering N. E. and a fresh breeze
ends thus 24 hours. Lat 44.25 Long 149.15 E

Wednesday Dec 3rd 1845

Begins with strong breeze from W. S. W. steering
N. E. with main & gallant sail cut the latter part
the same and reef the main sail to head and
beet and reef ends thus 24 hours with
clear weather. Lat 42.40 Long 152.59 E
