Begins with fresh breeze from the South and steering to the North the land to the Eastward of the middle & latter smalls of rain & small

Begins with strong breeze from S.E. and squalls of rain the middle and latter part the same and saw nothing of note

Monday June 22nd 1846

Begins with fresh breeze from S.E. and at 10 the weather the middle & latter part squally and saw nothing of note Lat 15° 45' S Long 169° 50'

Tuesday June 23rd 1846

Begins with strong breeze from S.E. and squally and the land in sight the middle and latter heavy squalls and hailstone in the Landward of the Land

Lat 14° 02' S Long

Wednesday June 24th 1846

Begins with strong breeze from E and heavy squalls and rain in the Landward of the Land the middle & latter part running down for Opolo

Thursday June 25th 1846

Begins with fine breeze from S.E. and at 8 P.M. close in to Opolo and left of shore at 8 P.M. got ready for to anchor at Murchison of the Harbour

Friday June 26th 1846

Begins with fine weather and at 10 go the Anchors in 5 fathoms of water in harbour on the middle and latter smalls getting ready & so forth

Saturday June 27th 1846

Begins with fine weather and the middle and latter part the same and saw nothing of note In Port

Sunday June 28th 1846

Begins with fine weather and one watch on Liberty the latter part the same

Monday June 29th 1846

Begins with fine weather and employed in ship & one watch on Liberty latter part fine

Tuesday June 30th 1846

Begins with fine weather and employed in painting ship latter part fine

Wednesday July 1st 1846

Begins with fine weather and employed in painting ship the latter part the same and on Liberty

Thursday July 2nd 1846

Begins with fine weather and employed about ship duty the latter part the same

Friday July 3rd 1846

Begins with fine weather and employed in getting wood and so forth one watch on Liberty

Saturday July 4th 1846

Begins with fine weather and one watch on Liberty so ends this day

Sunday July 5th 1846

Begins with fine weather and one watch on Liberty so ends this 24 hours

Monday July 6th 1846

Begins with fine weather and one watch on Liberty the middle and latter getting ready for sea to end

Tuesday July 7th 1846

Begins with fine weather and a waiting to ship men the middle and latter part the same

Wednesday July 8th 1846

Begins with fine weather and a getting men to day shift three the middle and latter part fine weather and a waiting for more men
