Tuesday August 4th 1848

Begins with fine weather and a breeze of
the Islands at 8 P.M. Shortland sail
for the night the middle and latter part
fine weather and saw nothing of note
so ends there 24 hours Lat Long

Wednesday August 5th 1848
Begins with fine weather and breeze
of the Islands at 8 P.M. Shortland sail for
the night at 3 sunset saw a large shoal
of whales and to Lat to Lower the middle
fine at 11 A.M. saw 3 whales 3 miles from
the Land so ends Lat 49.05 Long 80.55

Thursday Aug 6th 1848
Begins with fine weather at 9 has Murelian
Lowered and got fast to 4 at 4 P.M. took
them along side and at 8 finished boiling and were the
hullies of shore with the others at 8 P.M. Corn cutting the others
whales at 9 past 9 finished at 9 saw more whales and lowered but they
were frightened so ends in Chasing

Friday Aug 7th 1848
Begins with calm and weather and at
1 P.M. struck a whale and took him in
the at 8 took him along side and
and started of shore & Corn boiling
at 9 A.M. Corn cutting at 9 finished so ends
the Land in sight Lat Long

Saturday 8th of August 1848
Begins with fine weather and boiling and
a light breeze from the S.E. the middle & latter
part fine and at Murelian finished boiling so ends

Sunday Aug 9th 1848
Begins with fine weather and light air from
S.E. the middle and latter fine weather and
two Boats came off & we saw no whales of
note Lat Long

Frederick Islands
Monday Aug 10th 1848
Begins with light air from S.E. and
looking for whales the latter part calm
and employed storing down so ends
Lat Long

Tuesday Aug 11th 1848
Begins with fine weather and storing
down till the middle fine latter part
the same and finished storing down
Lat Long

Wednesday Aug 12th 1848
Begins with fine weather at 8 P.M. saw
them whales lowered at 9 past 5 struck
one at 9 past 8 took him along side
and at 8 P.M. Corn cutting
and so ends at 11 got the
body in so ends with fine weather
Lat Long

Thursday Aug 13th 1848
Begins with fine weather and at 4 P.M.
got the head in and Corn boiling the
middle and latter part fine weather so ends
a boiling

Friday August 14th 1848
Begins with strong winds from the Land
boiling the middle and latter part the
same Lat Long

Saturday Aug 15th 1848
Begins with strong winds from the S.
at 8 P.M. finished boiling the middle and
latter part the same and the Land in sight
so ends Lat Long

Sunday Aug 16th 1848
Begins with fresh breeze from the Land a
breeze to windward the middle and
latter part fine weather and no ship in
sight and no whales so ends there
24 hours Lat Long
