

Frege Islands

Monday Aug 17th 1846

Begins with light breeze from S. E. and close in with the Land & one ship in sight the Middle & Latta part for equally weather and strong wind so end the Low Island to windward of us

Tuesday Aug 18th 1846

Begins with strong wind from the S. E. and at 1 P. M. spoke the Sargassos of Kent had got one whale since seeing her before the latter part employed a staving down so end

Wednesday Aug 19th 1846

Begins with fresh breeze and staving down at 8 P. M. finished the Middle and Latta fresh breeze and to Leeward of the Land so end

Thursday Aug 20th 1846

Begins with moderate breeze and to Leeward of Low Island at 1/2 past 4 P. M. saw a school of 12 whales & lowered but might have on & could not get on the Middle and Latta part strong wind and so end then 24 hours & got no whales

Friday Aug 21st 1846

Begins with strong trade and under short sail close in to the Land the Middle and Latta part strong trade and under short sail close in to the Land Lat Long

Saturday Aug 22nd 1846

Begins with strong breeze from S. E. and close in under the Lu of Low Island at 5 P. M. took in sail for the night the Middle and Latta blowing a gale and unbenet the 1st & 2d sail but bent other 2 at midnight unbenet the Main Top sail to Morn so could Low Island close by to windward so the time go on Lat Long

Frege Islands

Sunday Aug 23rd 1846

Begins with strong winds from S. E. and employed Mending Mr. Tylor the Middle & Latta a gale and under short sail so end then 24 hours Lat Long

Monday Aug 24th 1846

Begins with strong winds and close in to the Land the Middle and Latta part the same and saw nothing of note Lat Long

Tuesday Aug 25th 1846

Begins with fine weather the Middle and Latta part the same and employed at work on rigging so end Lat Long

Wednesday Aug 26th 1846

Begins with fine weather and employed sitting up the rigging the Latta part took out the pump to look at them so end then 24 hours Lat Long

Thursday Aug 27th 1846

Begins with fine weather and employed about the rigging and 3 barrels came off the Middle and Latta part fine and saw nothing of note Lat Long

Friday Aug 28th 1846

Begins with fine weather and of Low Island the Middle and Latta part the same and saw nothing Lat Long

Saturday Aug 29th 1846

Begins with fine weather and Middle and Latta part the same and saw nothing of note so end Lat Long

Sunday Aug 30th 1846

Begins with light breeze and pleasant weather and of Low Island the Middle and Latta fine and no whales Lat Long

Monday August 31st 1846

Begins with fine weather and looking over the ground the Middle and Latta part fine and saw hump backs so end
