Begins with fine weather and looking over the ground Middle & Latta part the same & saw a plenty of Hump Backs so much

Wednesday Sept 2nd 1846

Begins with fine weather and looking about the Island the Middle and Latta the same and saw nothing of note

Thursday Sept 3rd 1846

Begins with fine weather Middle and Latta part the same and saw nothing of note so much

Friday Sept 4th 1846

Begins with fine weather and saw nothing Middle and Latta part the same and saw no whaled so much

Saturday Sept 5th 1846

Begins with fine weather and look in to the Low Island the Middle and Latta part the same and saw one hump Back whale & no sperm whaled so much

Sunday Sept 6th 1846

Begins with fine weather and of Low Island at 8 took in sail for the night the Middle and Latta part the same

Monday Sept 7th 1846

Begins with fine weather and of Low Island and starting to the S. E. and all sail set bound up to gas the Latta part wind a head and so much - Lat. Long

Tuesday Sept 8th 1846

Begins with fresh breeze from S. E. and beating the windward at 8 P. M. Herond Island in sight and last ship of the Middle heavy rain and strong winds & kept down Latta part Moderate and the Island of Sur in sight of the W. Bore so much Lat Long

Thorge Island

Wednesday Sept 9th 1846

Begins with fine weather and working up along the reef at 10 A. M. saw a Large whale and the weather thickened but could not get on so much in chase

Thursday Sept 10th 1846

Begins with fine and in chase of the whale at 5 P. M. it came on very thick and gave up the chase the Middle and Latta a strong breeze so much

Friday Sept 11th 1846

Begins with strong breeze from the S. E. and working to windward the Middle and Latta part light air and saw nothing

Saturday Sept 12th 1846

Begins with Moderate breeze from S. E. and a strong current setting to the W. W. the Middle and Latta sailing so much

Sunday Sept 13th 1846

Begins with fresh breeze from S. E. the Middle and Latta part fine and of to the S. E. of the Island of Sur so much and saw nothing

Monday Sept 14th 1846

Begins with fine weather wind from S. E. & looking over the ground the Middle and Latta part fine and of Sur

Tuesday Sept 15th 1846

Begins with fine weather and at 1 P. M. saw sperm whale and at 2 lowered got part it got one boat stove & got 4 whales at 5 got them along side



at 6 A. M. bore cutting at 10 finished at 11 saw whaled and lowered but got none

Wednesday Sept 16th 1846

Begins with fine weather at 3 P. M. the boats came on board and were looking the Middle and Latta the same and saw nothing
