

Bround South from Keatonah
Monday Oct 5th 1846

Begins with fine weather and at 7 A.M.
the Boat came of with the last wood
Punch we saw a large shoal of whales
lowered but did not see them after we
got in the water so small

Tuesday Oct 6th 1846

Begins with squally weather and the Capt
went on shore after hogs at 7 A.M. came
of 4 so small

Wednesday Oct 7th 1846

Begins with light airs and of the East line
of the shore latter part standing in for the
Lizard so small

Thursday Oct 8th 1846

Begins with light airs from the N.E. & at 1
P.M. the Capt went on shore to ~~land~~ a man
that was sick and get another at 5 he came
of with another & put away for the South
the latter part a strong wind. Lat 24° 40' Long 177° 40'

Friday Oct 9th 1846

Begins with strong breezes from S.E. and
squalls of rain the middle and latter part
the same and light sails in Lat 15.50 Long 177° 40'

Saturday Oct 10th 1846

Begins with strong breezes from S.E. and working
to the south and the weather rainy light sails in
the middle & latter part rainy & wind ahead

Sunday Oct 11th 1846

Begins with strong winds from S.E. and under
double reef of sails the weather thick the middle
and latter part much the same Lat 14.00 Long 176.25 W.

Monday Oct 12th 1846

Begins with strong winds from S.E. and
working to windward the middle and
latter part much the same heading S.E.
Lat . . . Long . . .

Tuesday Oct 13th 1846

Begins with strong breezes from S.E. heading S.E.
the middle the same latter part moderate and
light sails in Lat 15.50 Long 178.40 E.

Wednesday Oct 14th 1846

Begins with fine weather and S.E. and
heading to the South at 4 past to the eastward
the middle and latter part moderate Lat
Long

Thursday Oct 15th 1846

Begins with light breezes and at 1 P.M. saw a small
island a head the middle and latter the same and
saw nothing Lat Long

Friday Oct 16th 1846

Begins with light breezes from the S.E. and heading
to the South the middle and latter part moderate
breezes and saw nothing Lat Long

Saturday Oct 17th 1846

Begins with fine breezes from S.E. and heading
to the S.E. the middle and latter part . . .
and saw nothing of note Lat 19.50 Long 177.40 E.

Sunday Oct 18th 1846

Begins with fresh breezes from S. and heading
to the S. the middle and latter part the
same & weather thick Lat 20.42 Long 178.20

Monday Oct 19th 1846

Begins with moderate the middle & latter
part the same & weather thick and heading
S.E. so small Lat 21.04 Long 178.40 E.

Tuesday Oct 20th 1846

Begins with light breezes from N.E. and
heading to the S.E. & imploring the
main top sail the middle and latter fine weather
so small Lat 21.44 Long 179.00 E.

Wednesday Oct 21th 1846

Begins with fine breezes from S. and steering
N.E. the middle and latter part a strong
breeze and light sails in Lat 23.40 Long 179.00 E.
