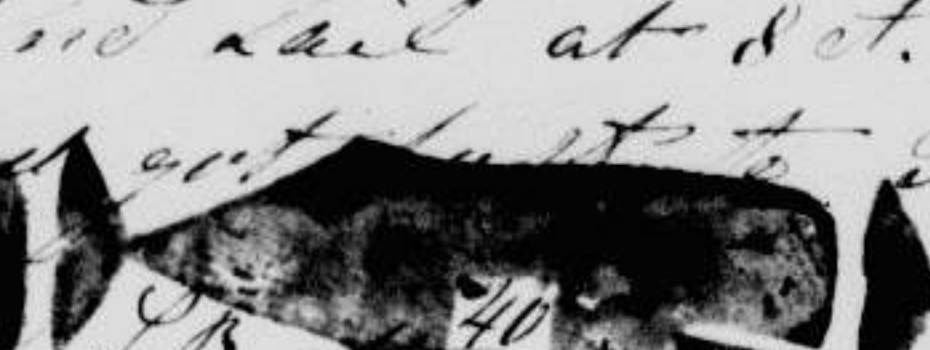


New Zealand & Three Kings

Begins with light breeze from S. and
fine weather. Latta part heading to the South
and saw nothing. Lat 34.55 S. Long 174.50 E.

Monday Dec 16th 1845
Begins with fine weather and heading S.
at 2 P.M. made the land ahead at 4 P.M.
held on. At 11 P.M. started sail at 8 P.M. saw
sp. who  went fast to S. and the
was the   Lat 34.55 S. Long 174.50 E.

Tuesday Dec 17th 1845
Begins fine at 3 P.M. and the third whale along
side and soon but
at 4 spoke the S. of 8. B. 25 M. 15.00 in
the Latta part a distance of 100 miles

Wednesday Dec 18th 1845
Begins fine & boiling the middle and
Latta part the same Lat 34.55 S. Long 174.50 E.

Thursday Dec 19th 1845
Begins with calm weather and boiling
the middle and Latta part the same and
the Kings in sight to the S.E. 10 miles
Lat 34.55 S. Long 174.50 E.

Friday Dec 20th 1845
Begins with calm weather and boiling and
spoke the S. of 8. B. 1300 M. at 6 P.M.
spoke fine the boiling 10 miles Lat 34.55 S. Long 174.50 E.

Saturday Dec 21st 1845
Begins with calm weather and a sail in
sight middle a breeze from the S. the middle
the same & the Kings in sight

Sunday Dec 22nd 1845
Begins with fine weather and spoke Bark
London Pack 800 the middle and Latta part
fine weather

Monday Dec 23rd 1845
Begins with fine weather and steering down the
middle and Latta part the same and so
on

New Zealand & Three Kings
Tuesday Dec 24th 1845
Begins with fine weather and steering down
at 8 P.M. finished at 10 past 11 saw sp. whale
and Latta to end

Wednesday Dec 25th 1845
Begins fine and in chase of whales got fast to
one at 8 P.M. took him along side and at 10
finished. Latta him in  Latta part
fine and boiling

Thursday Dec 26th 1845
Begins with fine breeze and boiling the middle
and Latta part the same and at 9 P.M. cold
down to end

Friday Dec 27th 1845
Begins with fine weather and spoke the Latta part
of 8. B. 1000 M. the Latta part fine weather
and a plenty of ships in sight

Saturday Dec 28th 1845
Begins with fine weather and at 5 P.M. comm.
steering down so cold that 24 hours

Sunday Dec 29th 1845
Begins with fine weather at 2 P.M. finished
steering down the Latta fine and the Kings
in sight

Monday Dec 30th 1845
Begins with fine weather the middle and
Latta part the same and saw nothing of note

Tuesday Dec 31st 1845
Begins with fine weather middle and Latta
part the same and saw nothing of note

Wednesday Dec 30th 1845
Begins with strong winds from the South and
the Kings in sight to Latta the middle and
Latta part the same

Thursday Dec 31st 1845
Begins with strong winds from the South the
middle and Latta the same and the Kings in
sight to Latta Lat 33.55 S. Long 174.50 E.
