Saturday Jan 2nd 1844

Begins with fine weather and S. W. and
breeze over the ground the latter part fine and
saw nothing of note. Lat 34.00 Long 11.10

Sunday Jan 3rd 1844

Begins with fresh breeze and the King in sight
at 10 AM spoke the Medway of Salem & London wh
& Iceland of S. before the latter part fine

Monday Jan 4th 1844

Begins with fresh breeze and thick weather and
breeze over the ground & employed in up. Shacks
to end that day. Lat 34.00 Long 11.10

Tuesday Jan 5th 1844

Begins with fine weather and at 10 PM spoke the
Sharon of N. London by Moon 1400 the middle and
latter part moderate. Lat 34.00 Long 11.10

Wednesday Jan 6th 1844

Begins with light air from the North and
headline to the Eastward the latter part a fine
breeze and the three lines ahead and so ends
the 24 hours. Lat 34.00 S Long 11.10 E.

Thursday Jan 7th 1844

Begins with a fine breeze from the North
and headline E. & N. at 10 PM past the King
& a ship at 10 PM made S. Iceland at 10 PM
sail for the night the latter part light wind
and headline in to the S. & E.

Friday Jan 8th 1844

Begins with fine weather and headline in far
Mauritius at 10 PM spoke in and head of far
the night at 10 PM stood in far the anchor at
& at 10 PM was anchor in & lathens of water & ends

Saturday Jan 9th 1844

all this day fine air & getting of water & the
times go on & the ship in part with red

Begins with fine weather and one watch
in Liberty

Monday Jan 11th 1844

Begins with fine weather and one watch on
Liberty & the 2nd sailing ship

Tuesday Jan 12th 1844

Begins with fine weather and one watch on
Liberty & the latter a giting & later on board

Wednesday Jan 13th 1844

Begins with fine weather and one watch on
Liberty & day the ship drags her anchor and we
at 10 PM the ship

Thursday Jan 14th 1844

Begins with fresh wind and one watch in Liberty
and

Friday Jan 15th 1844

Begins with strong wind and the latter
fine and giting body for sea one watch on Liberty
at

Saturday Jan 16th 1844

Begins with middle the same at 10 PM
took our anchor for sea with a fair tide & head
wind at 10 PM got out & anchored at 10 PM.

Sunday Jan 17th 1844

Begins with some breeze from E. & N. and at
10 PM spoke the Sharon of N. Haven 1000 the
latter headline N. N. E. and out of sight

Lat 33.50 S Long 11.10 E.

Monday Jan 18th 1844

Begins with some wind from E. and headline
N. N. E. under short sail the middle & latter part the
same so ends. Lat 33.50 S Long 11.10 E.

Tuesday Jan 19th 1844

Begins with strong wind from S. and headline
N. N. E. the middle and latter part the same and
saw nothing of note. Lat 31.25 S Long 11.10 E.
