Begins with fresh winds and squally weather the middle & latter the same. Lat 31.17 S. Long 178.20

Saturday Feb. 27th 1847

Begins with strong breeze from the South at 4 P.M. spoke the name of Fairhaven & bark from Port of S. B. the latter moderate weather. Lat 31.25 S. Long 178.48

Sunday Feb. 28th 1847

Begins with light air and calm the middle and latter part the same and saw nothing of note. Lat Long

Monday March 1st 1847

Begins with light air and calm the middle and latter part the same and saw nothing of note. Lat 31.44 S. Long 178.10

Tuesday March 2nd 1847

Begins with moderate breeze from the N. E. and the middle & latter part the same and saw nothing. Lat 32.20 S. Long 178.30 E

Wednesday March 3rd 1847

Begins with strong breeze from S. and sailing the latter part the same. Lat Long

Thursday March 4th 1847

Begins with a strong gale and sailing to the latter the same. Lat 32.39 S. Long 177.10

Friday March 5th 1847

Begins with strong gales the latter part pleasant weather and heading to the Eastward. Lat 32.54 S. Long 178.02 E

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Saturday March 6th 1847

Begins with fine weather wind S. E. and the middle the same at 4 P.M. saw 1/2 whale and had got fast to one and the boatmen at same on board the latter part fine weather and saw nothing of note & ended the 24 hours. Lat 32.55 S. Long 178.00 E

Sunday March 7th 1847

Begins with fine weather wind S. E. the middle the same latter breeze hard from S. E. and under short sail. Lat 32.40 S. Long 178.20

Monday March 8th 1847

Begins with a gale from S. E. and sailing to the latter part the same. Lat 32.59 S. Long 177.50

Tuesday March 9th 1847

Begins with a gale and under short sail the latter part moderate and wind S. E. W. and the middle & latter part the same. Lat 32.51 S. Long

Wednesday March 10th 1847

Begins with fresh winds from S. E. and the middle and latter light airs and two barks in sight. Lat 33.01 S. Long 178.08 E

Thursday March 11th 1847

Begins with fine weather wind from S. E. the middle and latter the same and heading to the North. Lat 32.08 S. Long 178.00 E

Friday March 12th 1847

Begins with fresh breeze from S. E. & and heading to the North & barks in sight at 4 P.M. saw 1/2 whale seen west of

but Knight came on & had no chance for them the middle and latter rainy & ended the 24 hours. Lat 31.40 S. Long 178.10

Saturday March 13th 1847

Begins with thick weather wind N. E. and sailing the middle and latter part the same and took a Breeze bearing Lat 32.00 S. Long 179.48 E
