Begins with squally weather and strong from the latter part the same

Thursday July 8th

Begins with fine weather and cruising over the ground the latter part the same

Friday July 9th

Begins with squally weather and spoke ship South Caroline of N. Bedford 35 men 1800 the latter strong wind

Saturday July 10th

Begins with fresh breeze and looking over the ground the latter part the same

Sunday July 11th

Begins with strong winds and a ship & barque in sight the latter part the same

Monday July 12th

Begins with fresh trades and looking over the ground the latter part the same

Tuesday July 13th

Begins with strong trades and no whales the latter wind from the S.W. and steering to the N.E. and no whales

Wednesday July 14th

Begins with moderate winds from the S.W. & steering N.E. round Island having S. dist 12 miles the latter part moderate and the Island of Key in sight having S. dist 20 miles so could a working up wind S.E.

Thursday July 13th

Begins with fine weather and working up Key the latter part past Key to it and so ends

Friday July 14th

Begins with fine weather and steering S.W. the latter part round Island so ends

Saturday July 15th

Begins with fine weather at 1 P.M. past round Island and at 4 saw the S. Caroline & Pacific of Fairhaven the latter part fine & no whale to be seen

Sunday July 16th

Begins with fine trades and a barque of Lee. Had the latter part the same and no whales

Monday July 17th

Begins with fine weather and looking over the ground the bark & ship in sight the latter fine

Tuesday July 18th

Begins with fine weather and looking over the ground the latter part fine and no whales

Wednesday July 19th

Begins with fine weather and cruising over the ground the latter strong trades so ends

Thursday July 20th

Begins with strong trades and no whales the latter close in to Lee Island and saw the bark

Friday July 21st

Begins with strong trades and from E.N.E. and heading to the South at 2 P.M. run over grass water at 3 P.M. took in fuel heading S.E. the middle a heavy bark from N.E. and of Amherst the latter part moderate Sat

Saturday July 22nd

Begins with calm weather the latter part the same

Sunday July 23rd

Begins with calm weather the latter part light breeze from S.E. and steering N.W. the land in sight

Monday July 24th

Begins with fine weather steering N.W. the middle and latter much the same and saw nothing Lee Island in sight
