Wednesday July 28th

Begins with calm weather and a reef close to at 4 past Meridian horns towing with all the boat at 2 P.M. got her of and took them up at 4 calm and the current taking her in we then towing again at 12 out her of and took a light sail the Schooner Sea Company

Thursday July 29th

Begins with calm also this the middle and latter part a light breeze and working up to

Friday July 30th

Begins with a fine breeze from the South and on to with the latter part fine in sight and the bark Swift

Saturday July 31st

Begins with strong breeze from E. and heading of N.E. the latter part the same

Sunday August 1st 1844

Begins with fresh winds from the E. and of N.E. with the bark & Schooner the latter part strong W. by S. wind

Monday Aug 2nd

Begins with squally weather the wind N.E. & strong W. by N. the latter part the same

Tuesday Aug 3rd

Begins with squally weather and around Island in sight the latter part fine and strong

Wednesday Aug 4th

Begins with fine weather wind E. and of around Island the latter part Low Island in sight

Thursday Aug 5th

Begins with fine weather and close in to Low Island & no whaler the latter part the same

Friday Aug 5th

Begins with fresh winds from N.E. and heading of the Low Island the latter part the same

Saturday Aug 6th

Begins with fresh winds from N.E. and the Middle & latter part wind N.W. and squally

Sunday Aug 7th

Begins with fresh breeze the Middle & latter part the same

Monday Aug 8th

Begins with fair weather and of the Low Island the latter part the same

Tuesday Aug 9th

Begins with strong wind and the latter the same and nothing to be seen

Wednesday Aug 10th

Begins with strong winds and the latter part two boats on shore to Low Island

Thursday Aug 11th

Begins with fair weather the Middle & strong breeze latter part Moderate and no whaler

Friday Aug 12th

Begins with strong breeze and close in of Low Island the latter part the same

Saturday Aug 13th

Begins with strong winds from E. & S.E. the latter part got a boat load of wood from Low Island and the weather squally to end

Sunday Aug 14th

Begins with rain weather wind from S. at 3 P.M. got the boats of and held on the wind to the S.W. Middle blowing a gale and bore to latter part more moderate and heading E. & Low Island ahead Lat 14.08 S

Monday Aug 15th

Begins with strong winds from S.E. at 2 P.M. kept of N.E. along the N.W. Coast the latter part wind from S.E. & heading to the S.W. at 4 passed and put up a bark of W. by N. to end Low Island to windward Lat 13.55 S Long 178
