Thursday Nov 19th Long 154° 55' E

Begins with fresh winds and a heavy sea
on, shifting to S.W. the latter part wind from W.
shifting to E. Lat Long

Friday Nov 20th

Begins with strong winds from W. Shifting to
at 8 A.M. saw a large whale going to windward.

Quick, several boats did not see him after
the latter a strong breeze Lat 38° 18' S Long 159° 40' E

Saturday Nov 21st

Begins with strong winds from the South. Latter
part shifting N.E. W. the latter part a strong wind
and saw nothing Lat 38° Long 159° 50' E

Sunday Nov 22nd

Begins with fresh winds middle and latter
part moderate Lat 39° 00' S Long 159° 50' E

Monday Nov 23rd

Begins with fine breeze from S.W. and
brushing over the ground at 1 P.M. saw a whale
leaving back one at 1 P.M. along side the
latter part but him in. Lat 39° 30' S

Tuesday Nov 24th Long 159° 11' E

Begins with fine weather and boiling the
latter part a gale from the North and cold down

Wednesday Nov 25th

Begins with same weather and the wind from
S.W. at 4 P.M. the weather falls and soon boiling
latter part the same Lat 39° 40' S Long 160° 00' E

Thursday Nov 26th

Begins with fine weather and boiling at 3 P.M.
finish the middle and latter part fine and
saw nothing Lat 39° 44' S Long 159° 57' E

Friday Nov 27th

Begins with fine weather at 4 P.M. saw a whale
and got part of one at 8 P.M. along side
latter part but in the body and
saw the head

Begins with a gale from the north at 4 P.M. soon
shifting at 12 Cold down at 4 P.M. parted the
head chain of Lat the head the latter part more
moderate Lat 39° 50' S Long 159° 40' E

Sunday Nov 29th

Begins with strong winds from S.W. and boiling
the latter part the same Lat Long

Monday Nov 30th

Begins with fair weather and at 8 P.M. cold
down the latter part shifting down

Tuesday Dec 1st

Begins with fine weather and shifting the latter
part brushing over the ground Lat 39° 40' S Long 160° 00' E

Wednesday Dec 2nd

Begins with strong winds and thick weather
the latter part the same Lat 39° 55' S Long 159° 45' E

Thursday Dec 3rd

Begins with thick weather the latter part rainy
and saw nothing Lat 39° 50' S Long 160° 10' E

Friday Dec 4th

Begins with rainy weather the middle a gale
from the South latter part more moderate

Saturday Dec 5th

Begins with light air and spoke mast
the mast of the vessel seen 500 the latter part
fair Lat 39° 50' S Long 160° 50' E

Sunday Dec 6th

Begins with fair weather and the bark
in company Lat 39° 50' S Long 161° 20' E

Monday Dec 7th

Begins with fair weather the latter part
a light breeze from the North Lat 39° 50' S Long 161° 00' E
at 11 P.M. spoke ship beyond of N. S. 15 miles
the latter part rainy Lat 39° 50' S Long 159° 40' E

Tuesday Dec 8th

Begins with a gale from the North and rainy the
latter part wind South and weather fair saw a Seal
and Black Fish Lat 39° 30' S Long 158° 50' E
