Begins with strong winds from S.E. steering N.W. at 1 P.M. saw 1 whale. Several got to the side and had two boats there and took a whale at 5. Took one whale along side and began taking. Lat 36.50 Long 179.00

Thursday Dec 30th

Begins with fine weather and boiling the latter part finish and a strong breeze from S.W. and nothing to be seen Lat 35.40 Long 179.06

Friday Dec 31st

Begins with strong winds from S. and steering N.W. the latter part steering down and the weather fine Lat 35.14 Long 179.20 E

Sunday Jan 2nd 1848

Begins with fine weather wind from S.W. the latter part wind N.W. and steering E.N.E. with a fresh breeze at 10 A.M. Made New Zealand Baring N.N.E. to end - Lat 35.15 Long 179.09 E

Monday Jan 3rd

Begins with fine weather and heading to the S.W. wind N.W. and thick weather & spoke a Schooner Lat 34.00 Long

Tuesday Jan 4th

Begins with fine weather and calm the latter part the same and trying to get round the Kerguelen Lat Long

Wednesday Jan 5th

Begins with fine weather and light winds the latter part the same Lat Long

Thursday Jan 6th

Begins with fine weather and spoke ship at Harshank of Plymouth 2400 and Bulk of St. James 1400, the latter part fine
