Begins fine and soon rain the middle and latter part the same

Tuesday Jan 18th

Begins with fine weather and getting ready for sea the latter part the same

Wednesday Jan 19th

Begins with fine weather and came ready for sea at 8 A.M. took anchor for sea

Thursday Jan 20th

Begins with a fine breeze from S.W. and off Cape Horn steering S.W. the latter part fine and the land out of sight Lat 33.30 Long 178.10

Friday Jan 21st

Begins with fine weather wind S.W. steering N. the latter part light air Lat 32.22 Long 178.11 E

Saturday Jan 22nd

Begins with light air from S.E. and heat to the N.E. the latter part heading E Lat 32.10 Long 178.11

Sunday Jan 23rd

Begins with fine weather and heading E & the latter part the same Lat 32.40 Long

Monday Jan 24th

Begins with fine weather wind S.E. the latter part a strong breeze Lat 32.37 Long

Tuesday Jan 25th

Begins with strong gales from the north and going to the latter part the same Lat Long

Wednesday Jan 26th

Begins with a strong gale from N.E. the latter part the same and one sail in sight Lat 32.29 Long 177.20 E

Thursday Jan 27th

Begins with strong winds from N.E. and the latter part the same so ends Lat 32.41 Long 176.53 E

Friday Jan 28th

Begins with strong winds from N.E. and heading to the south the latter part the same Lat 32.00 Long 176.10

Saturday Jan 29th

Begins with strong gales from N.E. the latter part rain and heading E & S Lat 32.51 Long 176.50

Sunday Jan 30th

Begins with strong gales from N.E. & rain the latter part wind from N.W. and moderate so ends this day Lat 32.41 Long 176.00 E

Monday Jan 31st

Begins with calm weather latter part wind from the S & heading S.E. Lat Long

Tuesday Feb 1st

Begins with light winds from the South steering N.E. the latter part calm Lat 32.11 S Long 178.09 E

Wednesday Feb 2nd

Begins with calm weather and two barks in sight latter part the same Lat 32.00 S Long 178.15 E

Thursday Feb 3rd

Begins with calm weather and two sail in sight & one whale latter part the same Lat Long

Friday Feb 4th

Begins with fine weather wind N.E. the latter part a strong wind Lat 31.30 Long 178.30

Saturday Feb 5th

Begins with strong winds from N.E. at 2 P.M. saw whales several got one at 5 took him along side Lat 31.38 S Long 178.17 E

Sunday Feb 6th

Begins with fresh winds and at 5 saw boiling the latter part fine Lat 32.18 Long

Monday Feb 7th

Begins with fine weather at 5 P.M. could down the latter part rain and saw two sail Lat

Tuesday Feb 8th

Begins with rainy weather at 2 P.M. spoke ship Charles of N. Bedford 1400 the latter part wind from S. and steering E.N.E. & two sail in sight
