Thursday April 6th

Begins with a gale from S.W. the latter part the same and Sandy Island in sight

Friday April 7th

Begins with a gale from S.W. the latter part more moderate and wind in a fishing to Sandy Island Lat Long

Saturday April 8th

Begins with fine weather the latter part the same Lat 32.15 Long

Sunday April 9th

Begins with fine weather the latter part the same and Sandy Island in sight Lat 32.15 Long

Monday April 10th

Begins with fine weather and went on shore and got 4 boat loads of wood Lat Long

Tuesday April 11th

Begins with fine weather and at Sandy Island the latter part the same S.W. Lat Long

Wednesday April 12th

Begins with fine weather steering S.W. the latter part fine Lat 30.28 Long 149.58 &

Thursday April 13th

Begins with fine weather & sent a new main & mizen top sail latter part mending a main top sail so ends Lat 31.35 Long 148.55 &

Friday April 14th

Begins with fine weather and steering S.W. the latter part the same Lat 32.15 Long 148.10 &

Saturday April 15th

Begins with fresh breezes from E and steering W. & S.W. the latter part fine Lat 31.55 Long 147.25

Sunday April 16th

Begins with fresh winds from E and steering W. & S.W. the ground latter the same Lat 32.10 Long 146.55

Monday April 17th

Begins with strong winds at 1.30 PM saw whales lowered got fast at 1.30 PM took him along side & took cutting at 5.00 PM for the knight at 8.00 PM cut him it blowing gale & cut the whale across the back at 10 got the body in board - Lat 31.55 Long 146.25
