Begins with a fresh breeze from S.W. and a boiling latter part cold down Lat 35.00 Long 176.07

Friday April the 21

Begins with light winds and a heavy swell the latter part the same Lat 35.50 Long 176.10

Saturday April the 22

Begins with fine weather and rising day. latter part the same Lat 32.20 S Long 177.30

Sunday April the 23

Begins with fine weather the latter part the same and saw a whale Lat 32.55 S Long 177.10

Monday April the 24

Begins with fine weather the latter part the same Lat 32.54 S Long 176.40 E

Tuesday April the 25

Begins with fine weather. latter part the same and saw nothing Lat 32.15 S Long 176.50

Wednesday April the 26

Begins with strong winds from the South and steering 80 at 1 P.M. saw a whale. Sounded got fast by it and at 3 took him along side

and got ready to cut latter part the dock sounds with rough weather Lat 31.50 Long 176.15

Thursday April the 27

Begins with strong gales and a cutting at 5 P.M. fire light and soon boiling the latter part a gale so cold Lat 31.50 Long 176.50

Begins with a gale from N.W. the latter part more moderate and boiling Lat Long

Begins with fine weather and at 8 P.M. cold down the latter part fine Lat 31.40 Long 177.30

Monday May the 1

Begins with fine weather and employed a stowage down the latter part the same Lat 31.30 Long 177.20

Tuesday May the 2

Begins with fine weather latter part the same and finished stowing down Lat 31.50 Long 177.50

Wednesday May the 3

Begins with squally weather and some rain latter part the same Lat 32.05 Long 178.41 E

Thursday May the 4

Begins with squally weather wind N.W. and under short sail latter part a gale from N.W. and came to Lat 32.08 S Long 179.02

Friday May the 5

Begins with a gale from N.W. and lying to the latter part more moderate Lat 32.15 Long 179.05

Saturday May the 6

Begins with fresh winds from W. steering 80 E. latter part a gale from S.W. Lat 31.50 Long 179.10

Sunday May the 7

Begins with a gale from S.W. and lying to the latter part the same Lat 32.00 Long 178.54

Monday May the 8

Begins with a gale from S.W. and heading 80 E. the latter part more moderate Lat 32.35 Long 179.05

Tuesday May the 9

Begins with fresh winds from W. steering 80 E. the latter part the same Lat 31.50 Long 179.50 W.

Wednesday May the 10

Begins with fresh winds from W. and steering 80 E. the latter part moderate and steering S.S.E. at 11 A.M. saw French Rocks 20 miles distant sound

and light Lat Long
