to the latter part fine Lat 34.15 Long 57.15

Tuesday June 6th

Begins with light air from the S. the latter part
a breeze from E strong S Lat 34.07 Long 57.48

at 8 A.M. saw the Por knights and the weather
here thick so could not see far Cape Breton Sound

Thursday June 8th

Begins with rainy weather and Cape Breton in
sight at 11 A.M. at 4 P.M. held to, the weather bad
middle part under short sail heading S.W. by N
latter part here to

Friday June 9th

Begins with a gale from N.W. & heading S.W.
the latter part a bad sea on 2 points under short sail

Saturday June 10th

Begins with a light breeze from the N.W. and a
heavy swell heaving on shore the latter part close by
the latter part of them some and the weather calm
