

C. W. Morgan homeward bound

8. Saturday Sept 30th 1842

Begins with light airs from N.N.W. steering E.S.E. the middle the latter part heading N.N.E. the weather thick and a fine breeze Lat 45.47. Long 45.12. W.

9. Sunday Oct 1st

Begins with a fine breeze from W.N.W. steering N. and saw a ship heading to the North the latter part a fine breeze from S.W. two ships in sight 24 miles then 24 hours Lat 43.30 Long 45.12. W.

10. Monday Oct 2nd

Begins with fresh winds from S.E. W. steering N. by W. with all sail set the latter a fresh breeze and employed in taking up the sheeting Lat 40.34 Long 45.09

11. Tuesday Oct 3rd

Begins with strong winds from S. steering N. by W. the middle and latter part the same Lat 38.15 Long 44.45. W.

12. Wednesday Oct 4th

Begins with strong winds from S. and squally steering N. middle steering N.N.E. latter part squally winds then 24 hours Lat 35.38 Long 44.00

13. Thursday Oct 5th

Begins with a strong wind from S. steering N.E. the latter part wind W. winds Lat 34.04 Long 41.15. W.

14. Friday Oct 6th

Begins with a strong wind from W. steering N.E. the middle & latter fine weather Lat 31.54 Long 39.25

15. Saturday Oct 7th

Begins with fine weather and a light breeze from S.E. W. steering N.E. by N. the latter fine weather and at work on rigging 24 hours Lat 30.04 Long 37.30

16. Sunday Oct 8th

Begins with fine weather steering N.E. the middle and latter part wind from E. and sharp on the wind 24 hours then 24 hours Lat 28.10 Long 37.00

17. Monday Oct 9th

Begins with light breezes from E. heading N. and N.N.E. the latter part winds backing from E. to S.E. 24 hours Lat 26.55 Long 37.04. W.

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18. Tuesday Oct 10th

Begins with a light breeze from E. heading N.N.E. the middle the same at 9 A.M. saw a school of sperm whales several but none taken and at 4 P.M. came on board Lat 25.45 Long 37.09. W.

19. Wednesday Oct 11th

Begins with a fair breeze from E. heading N.N.E. the middle part the same Lat 24.11 Long 37.05

20. Thursday Oct 12th

Begins with strong winds from E. & by N.E. steering by the wind the latter part a strong wind so could sail in sight Lat 23.09 Long 36.44

21. Friday Oct 13th

Begins with strong trades from E. and heading N.N.E. the latter part the same Lat 20.38 Long 36.22

22. Saturday Oct 14th

Begins with strong winds from E. heading N.N.E. the middle & latter the same Lat 18.48 Long 36.36

23. Sunday Oct 15th

Begins with strong winds from E. N.E. heading N. the middle and latter part the same Lat 16.48 Long 36.58. W.

24. Monday Oct 16th

Begins with fresh trades from E. N.E. steering by the wind & the latter part heading N.N.W. and at midnight last ship to the S.E. Lat 15.20 Long 37.20

25. Tuesday Oct 17th

Begins with fine breezes from E. N.E. heading S.E. by E. the middle and latter part the same and saw nothing of note Lat 14.34 Long 38.00. W.

26. Wednesday Oct 18th

Begins with light breezes from E. N.E. heading S.E. the latter part the same Lat 12.21 Long 38.00

27. Thursday Oct 19th

Begins with a fine breeze from E. N. and N.N.E. heading by the wind S.E. by E. the latter part a strong breeze from N.N.E. heading E. so winds then 24 hours Lat 18.00 Long 33.30
