

Ship. C. W. Morgan homeward bound

Wednesday Nov 8th

Begins with light air from E. steering N. by W. the middle the same at 8 P.M. a heavy squall from S.E. E. lets moderate Lat 9.18 N Long 42.53 W

Thursday Nov 9th

Begins with light air and squalls of rain and all round the cuppas at 13 took a fine track from S.E. by E. steering N.W. the latter part the same and fine weather painting ship. Lat 10.54 N Long 44.57 W

Friday Nov 10th

Begins with a fine track from N.E. steering N.W. by N. & painting ship inside the latter part fine weather and saw one sail hauls Lat 13.02 N Long 47.49 W

Saturday Nov 11th

Begins with fine tracks steering N.W. the middle and latter part the same Lat 14.53 N Long 49.19 W

Sunday Nov 12th

Begins with a fine track from E.N.E. steering N.W. the middle & latter light air Lat 16.09 N Long 50.48 W

Monday Nov 13th

Begins with light tracks from N.E. steering N.W. by N. and saw one sail steering N. the latter part very light air Lat 17.11 N Long 52.08 W

Tuesday Nov 14th

Begins with light air from E. steering N.W. by N. the middle and latter part the same & steering N.W. hauls Lat 18.08 N Long 54.02 W

Wednesday Nov 15th

Begins with light air from the S.E. steering N.W. the middle and latter part light air and making slow headway Lat 18.55 N Long 54.00 W

Thursday Nov 16th

Begins with light air from S.E. steering N.W. the middle and latter part the same Lat 19.21 N Long 53.18 W

Friday Nov 17th

Begins with light air from E. steering N.W. by W. the middle & latter part the same Lat 19.40 Long 54.00 W

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Saturday Nov 18th

Begins with a light breeze from N.W. heading N.W. fine weather the latter part wind from W. N.W. heading S.W. and calm Lat 19.35 N

Sunday Nov 19th

Begins with calm weather and heading round & found one sail in sight the latter squalls & calm steering N.W. Lat 19.40 N Long 54.54 W

Monday Nov 20th

Begins with calm and soon another a squall & making but little progress the middle & latter part a breeze from E. steering N.W. by W. and saw one sail steering to the W. Lat 20.16 N Long 54.35 W

Tuesday Nov 21th

Begins with fine weather but calm at 4 P.M. a squall from E.N.E. steering N.W. middle calm latter not much better winds Lat 20.25 N Long 57.19 W

Wednesday Nov 22th

Begins with light air from the S. steering N.W. and employed a sitting up the ship's chains to clear and one a foul in the fun so that we had a hard job to get it up the latter part a breeze from the S.E. steering N.W. by N. one sail in sight Lat 21.14 N Long 57.56 W

Thursday Nov 23th

Begins with a light breeze from S.E. steering N.W. by N at 2 P.M. spoke brig Annette of Eastport 15 out bound to Gloucester at 5 P.M. spoke brig Lord of Halifax 15 days bound to Barbados & got no paper the latter part a light breeze from S.E. & saw nothing of note Lat 23.14 N Long 58.57 W

Friday Nov 24th

Begins with a light air from S.E. steering N.W. and making very little headway and employed a cleaning chains & to part the latter part a fine breeze from E. steering N.W. Lat 23.04 N Long 59.52 W

Saturday Nov 25th

Begins with fresh breezes from E. steering N.W. with all sail set the latter a strong wind and fine weather Lat 25.04 N Long 62.18 W
