Tuesday Oct 2nd

This day begins With light Winds from S.E. by E. Steaming S.W. by E. With all sail out at 1 P.M. Saw Black fish. crew employed in mending. Mungana and various other tops of ship duty. middle part light Winds from S.E. by E. Steaming S.W. by W. at 1/2 past 2. At 4 P.M. left the Island of Paul. Later part light Winds at day light Saw 2 Fishes and Black fish and con fish. So Ends

Wednesday Oct 3rd

This day begins With light Winds from S.E. by E. Steaming S.W. by E. at 1/2 past 2 changed the course to S.W. by W. crew mended various tops of ship duty at Sun down set the fore Royal middle part moderate breeze at 1/2 past 2 at 4 P.M. raised the land. Later part began at 1/2 past 4 lowered the Starboard boat and the Capt. Went on shore. Leaving off and on. So Ends

This day begins With strong trades leaving off and on after Nigres middle part strong breeze stalled off shore until 12 P.M. and were round at day light raised the land at 6 P.M. got Breakfast and the Boat went on shore. Later part leaving off and on. So Ends

Friday Oct 5th

This day begins With strong Winds from S.E. leaving off and on at 1 P.M. Boat came off and the counsel came on board and ship the men from St. Georges at 1/2 past 1. the Boat went on shore at 1/2 past 1 same and 11 the mugs. Came on board 10 of them and one half white. and the squall away middle part light Winds at 1/2 past 1. Strong trade in fore Royal heading S.W. by E. later part strong breeze S.E. by E. heading S.W. by E. employed in packing. Out the St. George's cash, and filling the men clothes. So Ends

Steaming S.W. by E. at 12 P.M. carried away the fore top gallant brace and ratenew ones at the main and back the main foremast employed in Stowing pack the whole. middle part moderate Winds later part the same employed in drying potatoes. So Ends this day.
