middle part light winds and calm
Steering S.W. by W. 1/2 W. latter part the same
nothing in site. So ends
So all 22, 58. Long 32, 26

Saturday Nov 28th

This day begins with light winds
from N. Steering S.W. by W. 1/2 W. at four P.M.
puffed up from S.E. and squally weather
sail middle part the same. One sail in
site latter part moderate breeze from E.
Bark heading S.W. by W. 1/2 W. no whales
Cook still sick. So ends this day
So all 34, 30. Long 24, 23.

Sunday Nov 28th

This day begins with winds from
E. Steering S.W. by W. With all sail out
no whales again going to the poor house
where I wish I was in purchase. At night
middle part light winds from S.E.
Steering S.W. by W. latter part the same
Cook still sick. So ends
So all 25, 30. Long 33, 52.

sail out nothing in site at 3 P.M. Steered
S. at sundown shortened sail middle part
the same at 12 P.M. came to the wind
latter part on the wind heading N.W.

main hatch because he could not steer
So ends this day. Cook sick
So all 25, 53. Long 30, 24

Tuesday Nov 30th

This day begins with light winds
and pleasant weather from N.E. on the
wind. One sail in site engaged in
turning in the main topmast jackstay
at 1/2 past 5. Took the man out of front
and sent him to the wheel, middle part
moderate winds N.E. Bark on the wind
latter part the same at day light let the man
out of front. nothing in site. So ends
So all 24, 42. Long 38, 21, 1/2

Wednesday Dec 1st

This day begins with strong breeze
from the N.E. Bark on the wind at 7 P.M.
Cook in jail and kept left steering S.W.
One whaler in site middle part strong
breeze from N.E. Steering S.W. latter part
moderated and thick weather employed in
mending sail. So ends. Cook sick
So all 25, 53. Long 40, 04, 1/2

light wind from S.E. Bark on the wind
latter part the same. One sail in site
Cook still sick. So ends
