This day began with light winds from S.E. clearing S.W. employed in picking over potatoes two sails in site at sun down took in sail, middle part calm latter part the same employed in mending had three ships in site to end
Lat 23.21, Long 41.48.

Saturday Dec 4.

This day began with calm nothing in site employed in mending sail middle part, light winds from N.W. clearing S.W. by W. latter part strong breeze from the Westward with all sail out three sails in site, no whabs to end
Lat 23.11, Long 42.24, W.

Sunday Dec 5th

This day began with fine weather and strong breeze from W.S.W. Bark on the Wind at sun down took in sail middle part the same calm part moderate winds from S.W. heading West, three sails in site to end cook salted back

Monday Dec 6th

This day began with fine weather and moderate winds from S. heading W.S.W. at sun down shortened sail middle part Wind S.E. clearing S.W. latter part the same saw grampuses two sails in site to end this day cook still sick
Lat 23.50, Long 45.16 W.

Tuesday Dec 7th

This day began with strong breeze from S.E. clearing S.W. employed in mending sail one steamer in site put a new main top sail, at sun down came to the Wind and shortened sail took in the fore top sail, middle part strong breeze latter part the same employed in breaking out to ends this day

Wednesday Dec 8th

This day began with strong breeze from S.W. clearing S.W. with double reefed top sails, took in the Siff to mend. saw grampuses, middle and latter part moderate and raining to end

Thursday Dec 9

This day began with light winds from S.W. heading S.E. on the Wind nothing in site at sun down took in sail middle and latter part the same employed in mending sail one sail in site to end this day
Lat 32.30, Long 48.05 W.

Friday Dec 10th

This day began with light winds from S.W. clearing W. nothing in site middle part strong breeze from S.W. at 12 P.M. came to the Wind at 5 P.M. kept at clearing S.W. saw grampuses and one sail employed in mending sail to ends
Lat 33.40, Long 49.24, W.

Saturday Dec 11

This day began strong breeze from S.E. clearing S.W. at 1 P.M. 5 P.M. squally thunder and lighters took in sail middle part moderate latter part the same Wind S.E. clearing S.W. and raining with thunder to ends this day
