This day begins with strong breeze from W. Bark on the Wind heading to the Southward. With all Sail Set the Whales in Site as usual, middle part Strong breeze from W. heading to the W. N. later part breezing on One Sail and Linpacks in Site employed in speeking. Out to Ends this day

Thursday Dec 23rd

This day begins with strong breeze from W. Bark on the Wind at 4 P.M. carried the fore top sail. Foot rope parted and split to the second reef. Sent it down and put another One Sail in Site middle part fine Weather and light Wind later part the same at 6 past 8 P.M. saw a large Whale turned and struck One to Ends this day

Friday Dec 24

This day begins with fine Weather and light Wind from S. employed in striking at 5 P.M. finished the party and got Supper middle part fine Weather employed in clearing away the fish at 4 P.M. called all hands and hooked on the Seal late part employed in clearing away the lead. To Ends

This day begins fine Weather all hands cutting up blubber. Started the Works middle part Boiling foggy. Weather later part the same To Ends

Monday Dec 27

This day begins with fine Weather and Wind from S. on the Wind finished Boiling middle part light Wind later part the same employed in Stopping down One Sail in Site To Ends

Tuesday Dec 28

This day begins with strong breeze from W. and raining One Sail in Site at 5 P.M. finished Stopping down and the deck cleared up. Pumped Ship middle part moderate breezing. With close reef main top sail. later part fine Weather Linpacks in Site employed in Topping Off Ship's duty To Ends this day

Wednesday Dec 29

This day begins with fine Weather and light Wind at sun down took in Sail middle part moderate breeze from W. on the Wind later part Wind N.E. clearing W. employed in speeking. Out to Ends
Lat 38.38 S. Long 58.04 W

Thursday Dec 30th

This day begins with light air and calm clearing. W. nothing in Site at sundown shortened Sail middle part light Wind heading N.W. later part the same employed in mending Sail Riggers in Site To Ends
