grampus employed in mending main top galent sail
middle part strong breeze from E. With heavy
squalls. latter part W. With equally weather
nothing in site to end no. 1st.

Saturday February 11

First part strong wind from E. Clearing E by N.
With all sail set nothing in site middle part
strong breeze from E. Clearing E by N. latter
part Wind E. Bark on the Wind nothing
in site to end

Sunday February 12

First part strong breeze from E. S. E. on the
Wind nothing in site middle part raining
With light Wind from E. latter part fine
Weather and light Wind from E. nothing in
site to end this day

Monday February 13

First part light Wind from E. Bark on the
Wind saw nothing to day middle part Wind
E. S. E. With rain. latter part moderate breeze
from N by E. Clearing E. nothing in site to end
Lat 29.54. L. Long 30.33. W

Tuesday February 14

First part moderate Wind from N by E. Clearing
E. With fine weather nothing in site at sundown
look in the light sails middle part strong breeze
from N by E. Clearing E. With rain. latter part
the same to end

Wednesday February 15

First part moderate and equally carried away
the fore top mast at 8 P.M. called all hands to bend down
the fore top galent mast at 4 P.M. finished and got
topper middle part Wind E. on the Wind latter
part equally Wind the same bent down the fore topmast
employed in getting the other one ready to end

Thursday February 17

First part calm. With rain at 10 P.M. sent up the
fore top mast at 4 P.M. made it tight fast and
got topper middle part fine weather and calm
latter part Wind E by N. sent up the top sail
yard top galent mast and yard to end.

Friday February 18

This day begins with fine weather and Wind
E by N. employed in setting up the rigging at
5 P.M. finished Raining middle part strong breeze
from N by E. With equally weather latter part the same
carried away top that preying on doubled reefed
the top sails to end

Saturday February 19

First part flowing strong came down to
close reefed main top sail flowing on strong
from N by E. at 4 P.M. took up the bottom middle
part Wind E by N. With rain latter part strong
light Wind from E by N. to end

Sunday February 20

First part light Wind from N by N. W. With
rain at 4 P.M. and 5 P.M. middle part
calm with fine weather latter part the same

Monday February 21

First part light from N by E. and fine weather
all sail set middle part Wind N by W. With rain
latter part freezing top stuck but sail employed
in various tops of ship's duty to end

Tuesday February 22

First part moderate Wind from E. With
equally weather middle part light Wind
from N by E. and fine weather latter part the same
2 sails in the employed in setting rigging to end
Lat 25.51. L. Long 21.18. W

Wednesday February 23

First part light air and calm employed in
various tops of ship's duty middle part light
Wind from E by E. latter part Wind from the
same nothing in site employed in working in the
rigging to end
Lat 25.24. L. Long 21.19. W
