sails middle part light Wind from S.E. latter part
Wind the same employed in cutting up the main
sailing the Island in site &c &c.

mending the fore sail &c &c.

employed in furling mast &c &c.

First part light Wind from S.E. Steering
nothing in site middle part light Wind and
calm with rain latter part fine weather
and light Wind from S.E. Steering S.W. by N.
One sail in site &c &c.

First part fine weather and light Wind from
S.E. Steering S.W. by N. Squally weather middle part light
Wind with rain latter part fine weather and
light Wind from S.E. by S. One sail in site
