part the same Bark under dupe refed Tappin's  
nothing in sight So End

Saturday April 1<sup>st</sup>

First part Strong trade from E. One Sail in  
sight at sundown took in the main sail middle  
part Strong trade from E. later part  
the same nothing in sight So End

Salt 15 1/2 Long 37 22 W

Sunday April 2<sup>nd</sup>

First part Strong trade from E. at 12  
A.M. wore round heading E by E middle  
part moderating Bark heading E later  
part fine weather and light Wind from  
E by E clearing W by E So End

Salt 14 20 Long 37 41 W

Monday April 3<sup>rd</sup>

First part fine weather and light Wind  
from E by E clearing W by E middle part  
light Wind from E by E later part the same  
clearing E W employed in mending Tappin's  
nothing in sight So End

Salt 13 30 Long 38 23 W

Tuesday April 4<sup>th</sup>

First part light Wind from E by E clearing  
W by E at sundown shortened sail middle  
part light Wind from E by E later part the  
same Two Sails in sight Bark clearing W  
So End

Salt 13 31 Long 39 33 W

Wednesday April 5<sup>th</sup>

First part light Wind from E by E clearing  
W at 1/2 past 1 P.M. raised Whales and several  
boats and captured 8 W. the other boats  
chasing at 1 P.M. came on board middle part  
fine weather and light Wind later part Strong  
trade from E by E employed in cutting at 1/2 past  
8 P.M. finished One sail in sight So End

First part Strong trade from E. E. employed  
in Belling middle part Strong trade from  
E. employed in polling later part the same  
nothing in sight So End

First part Strong trade from E. Bark  
on the Wind finished polling at sundown  
shortened sail middle part Strong trade from  
E by E later part the same employed in Wash  
Ship So End

Saturday April 8<sup>th</sup>

First part fine weather and light Wind  
from E by E Two Sails in sight middle  
part light Wind from E by E later part  
the same One sail in sight So End

Salt 13 16 Long 39 28 W

Sunday April 9<sup>th</sup>

First part light Wind from E by E Two Sails in  
sight at sundown shortened sail middle part  
light Wind from E by E later part the same  
at 8 P.M. kept off for a while at 9 P.M. got  
close to and saw ship was cutting up to the W  
on the Wind So End

Monday April 10<sup>th</sup>

First part light Wind from E by E Bark  
on the Wind at sundown took in sail  
middle part light Wind from E by E at  
12 P.M. wore ship later part Wind E employed  
in mending the sail down below decks So End

Tuesday April 11<sup>th</sup>

First part light Wind from E by E One Sail  
in sight at sundown took in sail middle  
part light Wind later part Strong trade at 1/2 past 5  
P.M. raised Whales at 1/2 past 6 and captured 8 W  
them So End
