Sunday June 1st

First part light air and calm One sail in sight
middle part light wind, laying short between
Hoy and St George latter part light wind from NW
all in sight So Ends

Monday June 2nd

First part light air and calm Two sails and a
thunder middle part calm latter part light wind
from NW 4 sails in sight So Ends

Tuesday June 3rd

First part light wind from NW three islands in
sight employed in picking up shoals for water middle
part light wind from NW latter part wind
from NW employed setting up shoals So Ends

Wednesday 4th

First part strong breeze from NW, beating
for Hoy middle part the same latter
part wind of E, at 10 o'clock came to anchor
in Hoy Harbor So Ends

Thursday June 5th

First part moderate breeze employed in picking
up middle part strong breeze latter part
the same but a little full of oil on board the
Bark of yard So Ends

Friday June 6th

First part strong breeze from NE employed
in getting water and sending oil on board the of yard
middle part strong breeze latter part

Saturday June 7th

First part strong breeze from NE at 11, Hoy
in sight middle part strong breeze latter part
the same, one sail in sight So Ends

Sunday June 8th

First part strong breeze from NE at 2 o'clock
tacked ship middle part the same latter part
strong breeze from NE at day light tacked the
land Filad and Carro So Ends

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Bound to Carro after noon

Wednesday June 11th

First part moderate breeze Two sails in sight
at 4 o'clock tacked in Carro middle part light
wind from NW latter part the same So Ends

Thursday June 12th

First part moderate wind from NW, laying
off and on Carro, to rugged to land middle
part light wind from NW, laying to within
of the Island latter part wind the same at 8 o'clock
boat went on shore off Endy Boat on shore

Friday June 13th

First moderate wind from NW at 3 o'clock
Boat came on board and hoisted for St. George
at 4 o'clock Capt went on shore middle part
laying off the Island latter part the same at
10 o'clock Boat and Capt came
on board with seven men, taken off the Boat
So Ends

Saturday June 14th

First part wind of NE beating round the Island
after 2 o'clock middle part the same latter part
light wind from NE at 12 o'clock Boat came
on shore after Capt put did not
get on One man run away at 10 o'clock Boat came
on board So Ends

Sunday June 15th

First part light wind of E by E, steady
at 1 o'clock One sail in sight middle
part wind the same latter part wind
the same clearing E by E at 9 o'clock Saw
the land Island of Hoy So Ends

Monday June 16th

First part strong breeze from NE, Steady
at 1 o'clock middle part calm latter part
the same So Ends
