First part light wind from S by E. Steaming W. middle part the same latter part employed in putting the anchors on the jaw and blowing chain rope. To End

Wednesday June 28

First part light wind from S by E. Steaming W. middle part the same latter part employed in various parts of ship's duty Steaming W. To End
Lat 36 3 2 Long 32 4 8

Thursday June 29

First part light wind from S by E. Steaming W. W. at 4 past 12 shortened sails and changed watches and lowered to practice middle part light wind Steaming W. W. latter part the same employed in spreading sail To End

Friday June 30

First part light wind from S by E. Steaming W. W. employed in mending sail One sail in light at 6 P.M. lowered to practice middle part heaving two under short sail latter part wind S. by E. Steaming W. W. To End

Saturday July 1

First part light wind from S by E. Steaming W. W. at sundown shortened sail for the night middle part under short sail latter part light wind from S by W. 4 sails in light To End

Sunday July 2

First part light and 4 sails in light middle part the same latter part calm One sail in light To End

Monday July 3

First part light and calm at 4 P.M. kept off for a whaler to board the Bark S. Wallon middle part light wind latter part the same three sails in light To End

Cruising in the Western Breeze

Sunday July 4 the last

First part light wind W. W. One sail in light middle part and latter the same employed in scraping iron work. To End Good fourth for me

Wednesday July 5

First part light wind W. W. W. Steaming in light middle part the same latter part wind S by W. Steaming W. W. Saw black fish To End

Thursday July 6

First part squally and light wind W. W. W. Steaming W. nothing in light middle part light bark under short sail latter part light wind W. W. W. three sails in light To End

Friday July 7

First part light wind One whaler in sight at 4 P.M. kept off Steaming S by E. middle part the same latter part light wind One sail in light To End

Saturday July 8

First part light wind from W by S. employed in various parts of ship's duty middle part light wind from S by E. latter part the same three sails in light To End

Sunday July 9

First part strong breeze from S by E. Two sails in light middle part light wind latter part the same One steamer and a Brig in sight To End this day Lat 30 25 Long 35 20

Monday July 10

First part light wind from S by W. with all sail out middle part wind the same latter part strong breeze from S by W. One sail in light To End

Tuesday July 11

First part strong breeze from S by W. One steamer and One sail whaler middle part light wind under short sail latter part blowing strong To End
