Wednesday Oct 18th

First part light wind from S.E. nothing in sight middle part light wind from S.E. latter part wind S.E. S. nothing in sight So Ends

Lat 23° 54' S. Long 34° 29' W

Thursday Oct 19th

First part light wind from S.E. S. saw hump backs middle part wind the same latter part wind S.E. S. steering S.E. by S. 1/2 S. So Ends Lat 25° 32' N Long 33° 10' W

Friday Oct 20th

First part strong breeze from S.E. steering S.E. by S. middle part strong breeze from S.W. steering S.E. by S. 1/2 S. latter part the same So Ends Lat no observation

Saturday Oct 21st

First part wind S.W. and squally with rain middle part light wind from S.E. latter part wind S.E. steering S.E. So Ends

Sunday Oct 22nd

First part strong breeze from S.W. steering S.E. middle part the same latter part wind S.W. steering S. So Ends

Lat 31° 00' S Long 28° 32' W

Monday Oct 23rd

First part light wind from S.W. back under top sails middle part light wind from S.W. latter part the same So Ends

Lat 32° 02' S Long 27° 50' W

Tuesday Oct 24th

First part light wind from S.W. S. sail in sight middle part light wind from S.W. steering S. So Ends Lat 34° 32' S Long 27° 22' W

Wednesday Oct 25th

First part strong breeze from S.W. steering S. middle part strong breeze from S.W. came to the wind latter part the same drove main top sail So Ends

Lat 35° 43' S Long 26° 42' W

Thursday Oct 26th

First part strong breeze from S.W. middle part strong breeze from S.W. latter part wind S.W. steering S.E. by S. nothing in sight So Ends Lat 36° 43' S Long 25° 15'

Friday Oct 27th

First part light wind from S.W. steering S.E. middle part strong wind S.W. latter part wind the same steering S. employed in heaving new main top sail So Ends Lat 38° 32' S Long 24° 01' W

Saturday Oct 28th

First part strong wind S.W. by W. and squally at night took in to clad reef main top sail and put the bows and waist boats on the upper deck shifted the main top sail forward nothing in sight as usual middle part strong S.W. wind and squally latter part blowing a gale from S.W. So Ends

Lat 35° 50' S Long 23° 40' W

Sunday Oct 29th

First part blowing a gale from S.W. saw sperm whale came along side middle part wind the same moderating latter wind S.W. by S. saw 7 hump backs So Ends

Lat 30° 00' S Long 20° 00' W

Monday Oct 30th

First part light wind from S.E. at sundown cleared downed calm middle part strong breeze from S.E. steering S.W. latter part wind the same breeze on So Ends no Obs.
