calm. nothing in sight. So ends

Friday June 22

First part - light wind from S.W.
middle part - light wind from S.W.
latter part - calm. So ends. Lat 10.05 Long 144.0

Saturday June 23

First part - light wind from S.W. middle
and latter part - same employed getting
ready for humpbacks. So ends.

Sunday June 24

First part - light wind from S.W. by the
coast of Africa in sight. middle part
wind same. Steaming S.W. latter part calm
at day light lowered the boats and crewed
for whales. So ends. Lat 10.05 Long 144.0

Monday June 25

First part - light wind from S.W. by the
at dark boats came on board. Lat 10.05
middle part - rain. Steaming S.W. the boat
latter part - wind S.W. lowered the boats
So ends. Lat 10.05 Long 144.0

Tuesday June 26

First part - light wind from S.W. boats
down. Cruising for whales. Saw humpbacks
did not strike going fast. middle and
latter part - calm. So ends. Saw scores
in shore. Lat 10.05 Long 144.0

Humpbacking

Wednesday June 21

First part - light wind from S.W. ~~calm~~
middle and latter part - calm. lowered
the boats. Saw nothing but humpbacks
wet. No whale to day. So ends

Thursday June 22

First part - light wind from S.W. by the
middle part - same. Steaming S.W. & E
latter part - same. Saw the land
and humpbacks lowered the boats
at noon. at So ends. Lat 10.05 Long 144.0

Friday June 23

First part - light wind from S.W. by the
Saw humpbacks at 5 P.M. came to
anchor. middle part - trying to anchor
Saw Barks at anchor. Hired cutting
no whale to day. So ends.

Saturday June 24

#Y First part - light wind from S.W. by the
Bark laying to anchor at day
light. lowered the boats at 2 P.M. struck
a humpback at 1/2 past 8 P.M. lowered
her along. and So ends.

Sunday July 1st

First part - light wind from S.W. lowered
two boats and two boats cutting
Saw plenty of whales did not strike
So ends

Monday July 2

First part - light wind from S.W.
middle and latter part - same lowered
three boats employed minding blubber
no whale. So ends

Tuesday July 3

First part - light S.W. wind lowered
all the boats at 4 P.M. S.B. Boats
A truck parked line and A truck
and part line in the afternoon. So ends
