Wednesday July 18

First part light Wind from S.W. at
day light lowered all the Boat. Chased
did not fasten at 4 P.M. 2 Boats came
On Board and washed decks. The other
two came at dark the Louisa got one
to day To End

Thursday July 19

First part light S.W. Wind at day light
lowered all the Boat. Barkelbath's boat
passed round to the N. at dark came on
Board did not get away to day

Friday July 20

First part light Wind from S.E. at day
light lowered the Boat at 8 P.M. Weist
Boat struck at 4 P.M. took him along
side and finished cutting at 8 P.M.

Saturday July 21

First part light Wind from S.W. at day
light lowered 4 Boats at 11 P.M. Starboard
Boat struck part of line at dark Boat
came On Board To End

Sunday July 22

First part light Wind at day light lowered
all the Boats at dark came On Board
Saw nothing To End

Monday July 23

At day light under weigh and lowered
2 Boats 2 On Board minding Blubber
and pecking. Cut it later at 11 P.M. Saw
Whales and lowered the Starboard Boat
Passed the Bark Louisa Boiling at came
to anchor and the Boat came On Board
To End

Tuesday July 24

First part light S.W. Wind at day
light lowered 3 Boats and kept one in
get under weigh at 1 P.M. Came to
Anchor in 17 Fathoms of water at dark
Boats came On Board To End

Wednesday July 25

First part light Wind at day light lowered
4 Boats at 11 P.M. I spoke one of the
Destiny Boats 2nd mate hadn't seen
a Whale for three days To End

Thursday July 26

All the Boats off. Running at dark
came On Board with no Whale saw
a Scooner To End

Friday July 27

At day light sent 2 Boats off and kept
2 Boats to get under weigh and sent the
other two off after was under way
employed clearing up and getting ready
for opening the whaling at 4 P.M. I spoke the
Bark Palmetto at dark Boat
came On Board and made all sail
and bid good by to keep backing To End

Saturday July 28

First part light S.W. Wind and thick
weather. Crew employed starting anchor
unmanned cable and coiling line at 11 P.M.
Saw a dead Whale toward a Boat and
it proved to be a Sperm Whale. Took
him along side at 1 P.M. cut at 4 P.M.
employed clearing away keel and cutting
blubber at dark Boiling To End

Sunday July 29

First part fine weather Bark heading
Wet W. middle and latter parts same
employed Boiling at dark finished
To End

Lat 30° 30' Long 115° 30'
