## Remarks on Board Bark C. W. Morgan

Sunday July 31<sup>st</sup>

This day commences with strong breeze from N.E. and heavy swell from N.W. we made sail and head to eastward at about 10 A.M. Tack ship and head to north and W. Saw one vessel heading W.N.W. in the latter part moderate

Monday August 1<sup>st</sup>

*Change Top sail*  
This day commences with fine breeze from N. and Bark steered E.N.E. we saw three vessels heading eastward and we change main top sail in the latter part the same at. Sundown took in sails all but lower top sail and close reef fore top sail

Tuesday August 2<sup>d</sup>

This day commences with strong breeze from W. and rugged we made sail and steered E. Saw one ship heading to N.E. middle and latter part the same squally and rugged at Sundown took in main top gallant sail  
Lat. 37-24 Long. 40-27

Wednesday August 3<sup>d</sup>

Strong breeze and variable wind from W. to N.W. all day and squally in the first part of the day saw number vessels heading to East in the latter more moderate

Thursday August 4<sup>th</sup>

This day commences with fresh breeze from N.E. and heavy swell from N.W. and Bark steering about S.E. but in the latter we hauled to E.S.E. Saw number vessels at Sundown took in light sails

Friday August 5<sup>th</sup>

Fine breeze and pleasant all this day the Bark heading to E.S.E. with wind from N.E. Saw one vessel heading to N.W.

Saturday August 6<sup>th</sup>

*Spoke Minerva and gamen*  
This day begins with light breeze from N.E. and Pleasant Bark heading to E.E. with all sails out in the latter part saw Bark Minerva and spoke her and gamen left off gamen at 7.30 took in light sails and head to westward

Sunday August 7<sup>th</sup>

Light breeze from E.N.E. all this day and ship steered N.W. in the first part of the day in the latter part steered W.N.W. at Sundown took in light sails  
Lat. 37-38 Long. 37-26

Monday August 8<sup>th</sup>

Light breeze from E.N.E. in the first part in the latter part breeze from E. and pleasant Barque steered W. by N.

Tuesday August 9<sup>th</sup>

*Saw Black fish*  
This day begins with light breeze from E. and pleasant Barque steering W. at 7.30 A.M. Raised Black fish we lower four boats but no chance in the latter part the wind died out light air from S.

Wednesday August 10<sup>th</sup>

This day commences with calm in the first part in the latter part light breeze from S.W. and Barque heading to westward Saw one vessel heading to N.E.

Thursday August 11<sup>th</sup>

Light breeze from S. to S.E. and and Barque steering about W. by S. with sails out saw two vessels
