Remarks on Board Bark C. W. Morgan

Friday August 12th

Light breeze from S. and pleasant Breeze
steering about W. with all sails out we saw
number vessels heading to South and east
Long. 44-30 W.

Saturday August 13th

Light breeze from S. in the first part
of the day and Breeze steered W. in
the latter part wind hauled to S.E.
Saw two sailing vessels and one
steamer heading westward
Lat. 36-24

Sunday August 14th

Light breeze from E.S.E. and Breeze
steering W. with all sails out there
one vessel heading to eastward

Monday August 15th

Fine breeze from S.E. and Breeze
steering W. in the first part of the day
in the latter part the same we saw
three whalers and one steamer but
we did not find them out at sun
down took in sails

Tuesday August 16th

This begins with fresh breeze from S.E.
and clear weather we made sail and
steered long by the wind saw three
whalers and then saw one lower
two boats and Chale whale and fi-
nely the other lower four boats
then we lowered our four boats but
no chance for us those two ships
got whale

Wednesday August 17th

Fresh breeze from S.E. in the first part
in the latter part strong and Breeze
crisscross heading to westward we saw
the vessels it was in sight day before
at sundown we took in sail close reef
two top sails

Thursday August 18th

Strong breeze from S.E. and heavy swell
from S. the Breeze steered W.S.W. in
the first part of the day saw one vessel
but in the latter part moderate and
smoky the steered W.N.W. at sundown
we took all sails but close reef top
sails

Friday August 19th

Fresh breeze from S.E. in the first part
in latter part light breeze and squally
Saw three vessels and saw Blackfish
we lowered but no chance weather squally

Saturday August 20th

Light breeze from S. and S.W. with
pleasant weather and very clear Breeze
steering by the wind heading about E
to S.E. with all sails out we saw
three vessels and we took up Barrel of
Thorosino oil at sundown took in sail
