Tuesday Oct. 4th

Strong breeze from S. and rugged in the first part of the day at 6 A.M. we came off and steered N.W. at 11. came to heading by the wind in the latter part blow heavy and squally rainy wind hauled W. and we took in all sails but close reef main top sail

Wednesday Oct. 5th

Strong breeze from W.S.W. in the first part of the day and squally in the latter part moderate gale from S.W. Saw one vessel heading to E. and we are lying to under small sails Lat. 39-53

Gale from S.W. all this day and very rugged Barge lying to with close reef main top sail

Friday Oct. 7th

Strong breeze from N.E. and rainy at 7 A.M. we came off and steered W. in the latter part still squally at 5.30 P.M. we came to and took in fore top sail

Saturday Oct. 8th

Gale from E. in the morning and heavy rain at 7 A.M. the hauled to S. and blow heavy and Barge lying to with close reef main top sail. This day we wash ship in Gale. Lat. 39-56

Strong breeze from S.W. and heavy well in first part middle and latter wind hauled to N.W. and then to Port and still raining but wind became light and weather very thick we made some sail and hauled to westward

Monday Oct. 10th

Light breeze from N.E. and cloudy ship steering N.W. in the first part of the day in the latter part fine breeze from E. and we steered W. Saw two Steamer heading Eastward

Tuesday Oct. 11th

This day begins with calm thick fog and rain in the first part of the day middle and latter part fresh breeze from S. and still foggy Bark steered W.S.W. until we struck green water and then we hauled by the wind heading about W. Lat. 41-41

Strong breeze from S. and thick fog with rain in first part middle and latter part more clear and moderate breeze from S.W. Saw a merchantman and saw fun back

Strong breeze from N.N.E. in first part of the day at 7 A.M. we steered off S. Saw a steamer in the latter part thick and rainy steered S.E.

Friday Oct. 14th

Light breeze from E.N.E. in first part middle part calm latter part breeze from S.W. we steered S.E. Saw one Steamer and lower for a spar Lat. 39-40
